Code of Conduct for Parents & Guardians

At Chinnor RFC, parents / guardians and any others who attend with youth players are expected to:

- ensure players arrive in good time
- support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy rugby
- applaud good play by your team and by members of the opposing team
- teach your child that honest effort is as important as victory
- encourage your child to learn the laws and play within them
- accept match officials' decisions
- recognise the value and importance of volunteer coaches and administrators
- support the Club in offering a warm welcome to new members and to visiting clubs
- maintain communication with coaches and administrators about schedules / fixtures
- encourage players to stay in team groups when not on the field
- support the Club by helping out on match day duties (car parking etc.).
- do not enter the field of play unless invited to do so by match officials / coaches
- never to force a player to play against his / her will
- discourage unfair play and arguing with officials
- never punish or belittle your child for making a mistake or losing a game
- avoid swearing use correct and proper language at all times
- ensure compliance with rules on smoking, alcohol and drugs
- generally behave in a manner which brings credit to Chinnor RFC, and encourage players do likewise

Please note that Chinnor RFC has a disciplinary procedure, which may be used in the event of non-compliance by any member.
