Billingshurst FC were established in 1891 and later joined the Horsham and District League (1903-04) then the West Sussex League. They won the Division Two title of the latter in 1972-73 and then went on to win Division One the following season.

The club joined the Sussex County League in 2012 and finished fourth in Division three. They gained promotion to the SCFL first division for the 2016-17 season.

We've not had too many matches against Billingshurst, in fact our first meeting was only five years ago when they were promoted to the SCFL First Division. All our meetings have been in that along with our match last season in the Supplementary Shield.

In ten meetings we've won two, lost seven and drawn one.

On this day...

Oakwood 0-0 Burgess Hill Wednesday 28 August 1991 Unijet Sussex County League Division One Attendance: 150

Oaks garnered their first point of the season from a tough, uncompromising battle with Burgess Hill at Tinsley Lane on Wednesday night. Both sides, beaten in their three previous outings, will be pleased to have broken their duck but there wasn't a great deal for the spectators to enthuse about. True, a bumpy, rock-hard pitch made ball control difficult, but both sides continually preferred the long thump upfield when a more measured approach might have brought that all-important commodity... goals. With both defences in unyielding mood, chances were rare and for the most part the teams fought tigerishly for midfield superiority, a battle which Hillians' Sean Fernley and Jimmy Quigg just about shaded. Oaks had the first chance when Keith Browning steamed through a tackle before planting a 20-yard drive just wide. Browning missed from similar range just before the break while John Daubney hurried Hillians' best effort over the bar when he had a clear sight of Stuart Wilkie's goal.

Things perked up a bit in the second half and Paul Green had two glorious chances to win it for Oaks. On 66 minutes he swept inside Nigel Carr but fired straight at 'keeper Paul Hammond from 12 yards then, nine minutes later, he raced clear after robbing Chris Ridley on the edge of the box. After what seemed like an eternity, Green trundled an angled shot goalwards from 10 yards but Hammond was able to kick the ball gratefully off the line. Hillians' best effort, after a sweeping move upfield, ended with Richard Strange clipping a first-time shot over the top. A point each but precious little entertainment.
