League Two side Crawley Town first team gaffer John Yems played for Oakwood at the start of the 1995-96 season.

He was brought in by manager Alan Gould as a coach and he also made a couple of appearances on the field. Things took a surprising turn when Gould resigned only a couple of weeks into the campaign with Yems taking over briefly as caretaker manager before the decision was made to appoint Paul Crimmen and Mark Richardson as joint managers about a month later. John then spent time coaching in the USA.

(Wiki - edited) Montpelier Villa was established in 1991. Becoming members of the Brighton, Hove & District League (Montpelier being an area of Brighton) where they won Division Six in their first season. After winning Division Four and the Hove and Worthing Cup in 1993-94 the club skipped a division and entered and won Division Two in 1994-95 and Division One in 1995-96. They were runners up in the Vernon Wentworth Cup in 2003-03. In 2009-10 they were champions of the Premier Division and again in 2010-11.

Joining the Mid-Sussex Football League they rose through the leagues and finishing third in the Championship 2012-13 they were promoted into the Premier Division, finishing 8th in 2014-15. The club then applied joined Division Two of the Southern Combination Football League.

Villans finished fifth in the 2020-21, a season which was curtailed because of the COVID-19 pandemic, a supplementary shield was played and was won by the Villa. The club were promoted to Division One, entering step 6 of the English Football Pyramid for the first time. Montpelier Villa entered the FA Vase for the first time in 2021-22 but lost out 4-2 against Combined Counties side Abbey Rangers up at Addlestone Moor.

Most of the club's teams are based at the 3G facility at the University of Sussex, Falmer Sports Complex, whilst the first team u23s and u18s play at Culver Road, Lancing, the home of the Sussex County Football Association and Lancing FC.
