Pagham 1 Oakwood 1
Badger Ales Sussex County League Division Two

(Crawley Observer) A battling Pagham side managed to hold leaders Oakwood at Nyetimber Lane on Saturday. A Rob Wimble strike in the 89th minute rescued a point for the home side and ended manager Bob Pyle's 13-match consecutive winning streak. However things could have been very different had Zak Newman's effort after five minutes had gone in instead of clearing 'keeper James Leahy's goal, when Newman was set up by the livewire Nick Flint. Pagham manager Gary Block had called for a high level performance against the inform Oaks and his side certainly answered the call, denying space and time for Lee Butcher's troops after Newman's quickfire start. Brett Forden even saw one free-kick bounce back off Oaks' 'keeper Scott Kenward's upright after 25-minutes, before Leahy had to deny Flint and then Newman in quick succession, as the Oaks slowly began to gain a territorial foothold. Ben King was in sublime form at the heart of the Oaks backline and it was he who won possession and set-up Flint to put Newman in with a great chance to score. The experienced campaigner struck his shot past Leahy only to see the ball strike the foot of the far post, but Pat Dunning was on hand to stroke home the rebound four minutes before the break. The second half was a treat for the neutral with both teams searching for an opening. Kenward was alert to halt Sean David's effort from distance, while Leahy's fingertips twice denied the Oaks a second goal. However with time running out and Pagham desperate for a chance to level, got their reward with a minute to go. Striker Wimble found himself for once unmarked in the area and he guided the ball past Kenward to the delight of the Nyetimber faithful. But straight from the re-start, Robbie Gardner, on as a late replacement for Newman, almost won the game with his shot from a Dunning cross, but his shot grazed the outside of Leahy's post. With the very last action in stoppage-time, Pyle must have thought midfielder Phil Marsh had won the game as he rose unmarked at the far post to head home, but he misjudged his header and it bounced down and away to safety.

(edited from Wiki) Mile Oak FC was formed in 1960 and started in Division Eight of the Brighton, Hove & District Football League and won the division at the first attempt, and promoted to Division Six. Further promotion followed in the 1963–64 season when the club finished as runners up in Division Six and the club was promoted again the following season. The club's first attempt at Division Four saw them finish as champions, however four seasons later and the club was back in Division Five. A season later they were back in Division Four and the 1971–72 campaign saw them finish as runners-up and promotion to Division Two. The club had instant success in Division Two finishing as champions, a feat they repeated the next season in Division One. The 1980–81 season saw the club become winners of the Brighton League.

In 1986 made the decision to leave the Brighton, Hove & District Football League to become a senior club in the Sussex County League, and an application was made to join the Southern Counties Combination League, which was a feeder into the Sussex 'pyramid'. After just one season, the club won promotion to Division Three of the County League as champions.

After five seasons, promotion was gained to Division Two in 1991–92, as runners-up to Hassocks, and then to Division One as champions in 1994–95. They stayed in this division for three seasons, and were relegated back to Division two in 1997–98

In 2005–06 The won some silverware after defeating Sidlesham 1–0 in the Final of the Division Two Challenge Cup.

In the 2008–09 season the club again gained promotion to Division One but only survived one season back in the top flight of the Sussex League. They have been ever present at that level since then having a best finish of 4th in the table in season 2016/17.
