The club was established in 2014 by the chairman, Kevin Oakes and friends as a Sunday league club. They joined Division Two of the London & Kent Suburban League, and finished third in the division in their first season, resulting in promotion to Division One. After finishing fourth in Division One the following season, the club switched to Saturday football, joining Division Three West of the Kent County League. The Sunday side continued for another two seasons.

Welling won the Barry Bundock West Kent Challenge Shield in 2016–17 and were Division Three West runners-up, earning promotion to Division Two West. They went on to win Division Two West and the Kent Junior Cup the following season, also retaining the Barry Bundock West Kent Challenge Shield. The club then successfully applied to join Division One of the Southern Counties East League, a jump of three divisions.

In their first season in the Southern Counties East League, Welling were Division One champions, earning promotion to the Premier Division.

The club moved to Bayliss Avenue in Thamesmead in 2017 after Thamesmead Town left the ground. In 2021 they relocated to Kent Football United's Glentworth Sports Club ground.

## On this day...

**Shinewater Association 3-3 Oakwood**

**Saturday 11 September 1999**

**Sussex County League Division Two**

STEVE Turner's injury marred a six goal thriller at Shinewater on Saturday. Turner suffered a broken arm and cracked ribs in a fall after only 19 minutes on a rock hard pitch after a clash with home keeper Micky West, who cannot be blamed. On Saturday he had given Oaks the lead after just seven minutes. Chris Fionda's through ball found Turner who shrugged off Richard Rowlands before lobbing West. However, sub Chris Young made an immediate impact, scoring within 28 seconds of coming on with his first touch following good play by Steve Talbot and Pat Massaro, who was returning after three weeks out. Oaks then had thier advantage halved just after the 20 minute mark when Richard Booth's cross saw Wayne Lawrence give Steve Spencer no change in the Oaks goal.

They regained their two goal advantage six minutes into the second half, a good ball by Talbot feeding Garman who shrugged off Rowlands before rounding keeper West and putting the ball in off the far post. Shinewater pulled a goal on the hour mark when Talbot needlessly felled Clive Connell and Ross Osborne saw his effort well saved by Spencer but Ben Hutchinson was first to the rebound to slot home past Spencer, although the Oaks players felt that Hutchinson had gone into the area early after being told to wait until after the kick had been taken. Shinewater drew level when Connell's cross was put in by Danny Wild. Oaks nearly scored when Glen Woodburn's cross was met by Massaro but West pulled off a save. Oaks had a chance with six minutes left when John Mist's ball released Garman but the Oaks youngster just missed the target with West beaten.
