## Today's opponents: Midhurst & Easebourne

We extend a warm welcome to the management, players and supporters of Midhurst & Easebourne to Oakwood Park for our second meeting of the season.

The club was established after World War II by a merger of Midhurst (whose ground had been used to build a school on) and Easebourne (who had lost several officials and players during the war). The merged club played at Easebourne's Rotherfield ground. They applied to join the Sussex County League in 1980 but were rejected. However, the following year they were successful, and were accepted into Division Two. After finishing as runners-up in their first season, they were promoted to Division One.

They finished bottom of the division in 1986–87 and were relegated back to Division Two. They returned to Division One after finishing second in 1991–92 but were immediately relegated back to Division Two. The following season they were relegated again. They won Division Three at the first attempt but were relegated back to it at the end of the 1997–98 season, and after finishing bottom of the division the following season, left the league they dropped into the West Sussex League.

After winning the Premier Division in 2001–02 they returned to the Sussex County League and won Division Three at the first attempt, earning promotion to Division Two.

#### The Oaks vault - 30 years back...

Oakwood 2-2 Horsham YMCA (aet) 21 September 1991 Sussex County League Cup, 1st Round

(Crawley Observer) Oakwood laboured against Second Division opponents and will be grateful for another crack at this Unijet League Challenge Cup tie. They only had themselves to blame, surrendering a two goal lead to Horsham YMCA on a bumpy Tinsley Lane pitch, and failing to make the most of first half domination.

It all started so well for Oaks, after ten minutes Phil Richardson pounced on Stewart McCreadie's error to blast his side ahead, then 16 minutes later Gary Chandler made it 2-0 with a looping 18 yard shot. YMCA, who had lost their last five matches, looked destined for defeat until a superb 39th minute goal by right back John Tewsley changed the match. Oaks lost their composure, and only a fine Stewart Wilkie save ensured the home side kept the lead at the break.

But Wilkie was helpless on the hour to prevent Daren Champion equalising after a powerful Tewsley run. Both sides had chances to prevent extra time, Doug Cashman should have shot when clean through, and the dangerous Mark Richardson always looked capable of opening the YMCA defence. There was far more excitement in the extra 30 minutes, in which three marvellous saves left all the players gasping. The first saw Wilkie somehow claw the ball over after it cannoned off Peter Brackpool, and Andy Piper twice denied Oaks in the final five minutes. He parried a Mark Richardson header, and flung himself across the goal to beat out Dave Gate's 20 yard shot.
