(Edited from wiki) The club was established in 1892. Becoming members of the Mid-Sussex League, they were joint Division Two champions in 1951–52. After winning Division Four in 1959–60, the club were champions of an emergency Division Three competition in the weather-interrupted 1962–63 season. They were Division Three champions again in 1971–72 and won the Mowatt Cup the following season. In 1975–76 the club won the Division One and Mowatt Cup double. They won the Mowatt Cup for a third time in 1983–84 and the League Trophy in 1987–88.

After winning the Sommerville Cup in 1999–2000, another climb up the divisions began in 2000–01 when the club were Division Four champions. They finished third in Division Three in 2002–03, earning promotion to Division Two. The following season they were Division Two runners-up and were promoted to Division One. After a third-place finish in Division One in 2005–06, the club were promoted to the Premier Division. In 2010–11 they finished bottom of the Premier Division and were relegated to the renamed Championship division. They went on to finish bottom of the Championship the following season and were relegated to Division One.

The club were promoted back to the Championship in 2013–14 and were Championship runners-up in 2014–15, earning promotion back to the Premier Division. After a fourth-place finish in the curtailed 2020–21 season, the club were promoted to Division One of the Southern Combination League.

Forest Row play their home games here at Tinsley Lane.

It was Glen Woodburn who had opened the scoring in the ninth minute for Oaks before Garman scored in the 22nd and 24th minutes. Gerald Manville rounded off matters with the fourth goal on the hour to complete Oaks' fourth away win of the season. Oaks boss Andy Maddox is now set to lose Garman for midweek games for the rest of the season but has Kevin Payne on his way back from injury. Full-back Ben Short Made a successful comeback from injury at Southwick on Saturday.

**Oakwood 0-0 Crawley Down**

**Wednesday 19 April 2000**

**Sussex County League Division Two**

OAKS defied their lowly Division Two position to give rivals Crawley Down a run for their money in Wednesday's stalemate. Ali West and Andy Maddox' Oaks just failed to break the deadlock despite having the best of possession and chances, with Phil Butcher and Joel O'Hara dominating the midfield. An early chance fell the way of Oaks' Laine Eaton but he did not realise how much time he had and his header went straight at Matt Heasman on 10 minutes. Down's best efforts of the half saw Doug Cashman set up Danny Kemsley but he hit the side netting while Matt Stevenson beat three defenders before firing over. A quiet half also saw Oaks' busy Glen Woodburn send a looping header just wide while Colin Garman looked lively in attack. Trevor Brown cracked a left-foot shot just wide of Heasman's goal in the second half while Garman broke through but saw Heasman hold his close-range effort. Lee Hanson's drive was held by Michael Onions at the other end but Crawley Down failed to really get into second gear on a tough Oakwood pitch, and the home side continued to look the brighter. Late chances to sow up the points fell the way of both sides, as sub Darren Tidey put wide when through for Down and Cashman blazed wide with a free header. Oaks' sub Martin Comper went close when put in Garman but Heasman saved well and then Kevin Young set up John Mist, but his chip went over the bar.
