DPNC Emergency and Accident Policy and Procedures

- At least one qualified first aider at every coaching session
- First aid kit and fully charged mobile phone at every coaching session
- Contact details available at every coaching session.
- Visual Risk assessment completed at every coaching session and hazards removed.

In the event of an accident:

- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation. Is there danger of further injuries?
- Listen to what the injured person is saying.
- Alert the first aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries.
- In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services.
- Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised.
- Do not move someone with major injuries. Wait for the emergency medics.
- Contact the injured person's parent/guardian. Contact details are available through Pitchero
- Complete an incident/accident report form as soon as possible and return to Club Secretary.

In the event of a fire alarm:

- Evacuate all players to the yard area away from the gym
- Do not stop to collect kit or personal belongings
- Complete a register to ensure all players are out of the building
