Today's visitors - Shefford Town & Campston F.C.

Shefford Town & Campton Football Club (The Bluemen) is an English football club based in the town of Shefford, Bedfordshire. The team plays its home matches at Shefford Sports Club on Hitchin Road in Shefford and at Campton Playing Fields, Rectory Road in Campton. The club is competing at the 10th tier of the English football league system in the Spartan South Midlands Football League Division One. The club also has a reserve side competing in Division 1 of the **Bedfordshire County Football** League and an A team competing in Division 3 of the same competition. Originally formed in 1910 as Shefford Town, their first successful period came in the 1950s: starting in 1949-50, the team 2016 & 2017. won two South Midlands League championships and three Beds Senior Cups within five seasons. Subsequently, the club finished as runners-up in the Parthenon League, and won the United Counties League title in 1960-61. Shefford would not match these achievements until the early 1980s, when the club was promoted from the South Midlands League's second tier in 1982-83 and won the league title a year later.

After relegation in 1990, Shefford Town folded in 1994. The town remained without a senior football team until 2009, when the club was reformed. In 2010 Shefford Town merged with near neighbours Campton.

The club has had success both on and off the pitch in recent years since its reformation, the club were crowned Bedfordshire County
Premier Division Winners in 2011–
12, 2017–18 and 2018–19. The Bedfordshire County League
Britannia Cup was won in both 2011 & 2014, 2019 and the East Beds
Charity Cup was won by the Reserve team in 2015. The Club has also finished runners up in the Biggleswade knock-out cup in 2015, 2016 & 2017.

At the end of 2018–19 season Shefford announced its intentions to seek promotion into the Spartan South Midlands Football League, they duly wrapped up the Bedfordshire County League title and passed the relevant ground grading, so the club is all set to step back into the league it folded out of back in 1994.

The club is affiliated to the Bedfordshire County Football Association

The programme is an ideal pathway for students who wish to combine their further education with a high quality football programme when leaving high school or transferring from their first year of college.

. WHY IS THE ESPFA UNIQUE?

The ESPFA is unique to any other football & education study programme in the country and a concept no other can provide.

Unlike other programmes that are run individually, all member clubs are part of a national organisation with the education programme, football programme and the league they compete in, centrally managed with a tier of regional senior management staff to oversee the day to day operation.

The traditional timetable of this type of study programme is based around a matchday on a Wednesday afternoon. In the ESPFA, the time-table is designed around the students education with the three main days of classes and football training taking place on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday's with games on a Thursday afternoon.

Tuesday and Wednesdays with a game on a Thursday afternoon. Friday is the extra education day for Maths and English retakes and Extended BTEC workshops.

KIDLINGTON FOOTBALL CLUB

'THE STORY SO FAR'

Kidlington FC was founded in 1909 and played local village football where rivalry was so keen that players had to prove they were residents of the village for whom they played. In 1945, Kidlington moved from village football to play in the Oxford City Junior League, with a good deal of success. By

1951 the Oxfordshire Senior League was entered, where stronger competition was provided by the likes of Witney Town. Morris Motors, Pressed Steel and Thame United.

In 1953 The Hellenic League was formed and the Oxon Senior League lost some of

its stronger clubs to the new league. Kidlington won the Senior League that season and joined the new league in 1954. Early days in the Hellenic League showed quite clearly the difference in standard. Kidlington however, maintained a Premier Division place for a time, but spent most of the 60's in Division One. The 70's started with 'The Greens' winning the County Intermediate Cup. In 1976-77 a squad of good young players

produced what was Kidlington's ex-player Kevin Walton, the best ever run in an FA competition. The team played every round bar one away from home and reached the last 16 in the FA Vase, eventually bowing out to Gosport Borough. The nucleus of this side eventually gained promotion back to the Premier Division in 1979-80.

The 80's were pretty uneventful and saw Kidlington return to Division One of the Hellenic League. The early 90's were steady. In season 1994-95, Martin Bakers Reserve side did manager Paul Lee. There were

first team finished in third place and achieved promotion back into the Hellenic Premier Division. With promotion came a struggle with the considerable difference in the standard of football and the team finished in a relegation position. However a national non-league restructure saved

The new millennium saw a major overhaul of the committee and a new Chairman in Geoff Talboys. In 2004-05, under the guidance of

In 2009-10 came a new Chairman, Lloyd Wray, and a new management team. Explayer Gordon Geary was recruited to look after 1st team affairs and Barry Hiles to run the Reserve team.

Season 2010-11 saw the club achieve its most successful season ever, finishing seventh in the Premier Division, and a superb effort by all saw us play a very strong Oxford United
