

Guidelines for GCSE PE Students

Dear Parent / Carer

With a number of our Lioness and Lion U16s studying for their GCSE PE we do appreciate that their hockey is ideally placed to be used for their NEA development and analysis. However, in welcoming students to use training sessions and matches for their video & photographic materials we must consider the welfare and privacy of others in their coaching and match groups. In doing so, <u>BEFORE</u> any recordings are taken, students **MUST**:

- 1. Apply for and receive consent from their coach on behalf of all players on the pitch in coaching sessions.
- 2. Apply for and receive consent from their team coach and the opposition team coach (via their team coach) on behalf of the home and away team players on the pitch at matches. This should be requested prior to match day.
- ** Coaches and Managers should advise students if there is an issue with a particular player over video and photograph rights based on the player preferences signed for and approved with memberships.
- ** Coaches and Managers reserve the right to refuse recordings if they feel certain session formats or particular matches are not appropriate.
- ** All recordings and photographs can **ONLY** be used within the students NEA project they **MUST NOT** be shared online or on social media in any edited format.
- ** Respecting the privacy of our fellow coaches, managers and players is imperative.
