Due To Covid-19 FA & Government Guidance, Note the following:

Pre-Arrival	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The opponents must provide the name, email address and telephone number for their Covid-19 Officer or the Official in Charge of Covid-19 compliance at the game. All participants and all other attendees to complete a Covid-19 Self Assessments as per the Covid 19 Self-Assessment Guide issued with this action plan.
On Arrival	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We ask that all participants travel to game by following the Teversal FC Covid-19 Guidance / Action Plan For Playing Football Matches (page 6). Car parking is available, using parking bays as marked out. Please avoid congregating in large numbers and maintain current social distance guidance. Both teams are responsible conducting their own team Covid-19 briefing as per the Teversal FC Covid-19 Guidance / Action Plan For Playing Football Matches (page 23). Teversal have the responsibility to complete this with the match official/s. The home team's Official in Charge must ensure their official NHS QR poster is displayed for all to scan and record their attendance by using the NHS Covid-19 app. Anyone who can't record their attendance on the NHS Covid-19 app, to record their details manually for track and trace purposes.
Use Of The Changing Rooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use of changing and shower facilities will not be available, so players and match officials must arrive prepared to play the game. Changing facilities can only be used in emergency situations or by disabled people who are taking part in organised sport and physical activity. Toilets will be allowed to open, 30 minutes before and 30 minutes after training and/or matches. All government guidance on hygiene and social distancing measures must be followed.
Warm Up / Cool Down and Training Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Designated area will be assigned on arrival for the game. Warm-ups/cool-downs should always observe social distancing rules. If bibs are used, this must only be used by that individual and not swapped. Each team will be responsible for cleansing of items used during this activity and must be recorded on Team Pre and Post Matchday / Training Assessment document.

The Game	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Respect handshake pre match will be suspended until further notice.• Team talk huddles should not take place. But Team talks can take place if social distancing is observed and held outdoors where possible.• Coaches, other team staff and substitutes are allowed, but must also always observe social distancing on touchlines/dug outs.• Social distancing must also be observed during interactions when a substitution is being made.• Set plays – referees and coaches should encourage players to get on with the game and not unnecessarily prolong set play set-up, such as defensive walls. Set plays should be taken promptly to limit prolonged close marking.• Goal posts and corners flags should be wiped down before matches, after matches and at half time.• Goal celebrations should be avoided.• Interactions with referees and match assistants should only happen with players observing social distancing.
Post Match	<p>Administration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Teversal Team Covid-19 Official In Charge at the game shall ensure the Coaches or nominated person on their behalf complete the “Covid-19 Training and Games Briefing and Cleansing Record” after every game to confirm they have cleaned all equipment used as per the Covid-19 Guidance. The opposition Covid-19 Officer to ensure their Coaches complete their own processes.• Match reports to follow individual league guidance.
