

	• Coaches, other team staff and substitutes are allowed, but must also always observe social
	distancing on touchlines/dug outs.
	 Social distancing must also be observed during interactions when a substitution is being made.
The Course	Set plays – referees and coaches should encourage players to get on with the game and not
The Game	unnecessarily prolong set play set-up, such as defensive walls. Set plays should be taken
	promptly to limit prolonged close marking.
	 Goal posts and corners flags should be wiped down before matches, after matches and at half
	time.
	Goal celebrations should be avoided.
	 Interactions with referees and match assistants should only happen with players observing
	social distancing.
