Directions:

M6 junction 27 signed Standish. Follow signs for Wigan. At traffic lights in Standish centre turn right (signposted Wigan). After approximately 2.5 miles come to roundabout with Cherry Gardens Pub on the left hand side. Straight on and take first left into Leyland Mill Lane.

At the mini roundabout at the bottom of the hill turn left (Wingates Rd). Continue for approximately ½ mile then turn right onto dirt track / lane. The club is at the top.

Please respect our neighbours when driving up and down the lane and when parking. Please park on the main club car park on the left at the top of the lane.

We aim to return to the club house for the players' meals by midday

On arrival please meet outside the main clubhouse – please do not go direct to any changing room – you will be direct by one of the coaching team.

In accordance with Lancashire RFU Safeguarding Policy (Child protection) **parents are not allowed in the changing room** under any circumstances. Only CRB cleared coaches/managers will be allowed through the door. Please respect this policy as it is for the safety of children and parents alike.

The WRUFC officials will relay pitch allocation / playing numbers etc to the visiting officials. We are also required to give the numbers to our kitchen staff for meal allocations before we commence rugby so please advise on rough numbers in advance if possible.

After the match, **a meal will be provided for all players**. Please remind players to wash their hands before eating. Please do not allow your players into the clubhouse in dirty kit or rugby boots. Also trainers / shoes must be worn in the clubhouse (not just socks please).

The kitchen is usually open for spectators and coaches before during and after the game for tea, coffee, bacon butties etc.

RFU Code of Conduct:

Encourage players to be good sports and play by the rules

Do not enter the playing area during play

Never use offensive language

Never verbally abuse any player or official

Never publically question the judgement of an official

Remember all officials are volunteers!

Discourage players from using abusive language to officials or opposition players
