Common Courtesy

I will reply to all emails, texts, voice messages and facebook postings received from the Club, as swiftly as possible even if it is only a one-word answer.

Punctuality

I will be on time for all matches and any meeting, training or social event set by the Skipper, Coach or Manager. If I am unable to attend I will inform the relevant person in plenty of time.

I will inform the Manager if I cannot attend specific training sessions and will keep him apprised of my availability for matches throughout the season.

I will inform the Captain or Vice Captain if I have to leave straight after a game.

Appearance

I will ensure that I always arrive for matches in the designated attire as follows:
