



TFC CODE OF CONDUCT

Thamesview Football Club strongly supports the principles of the respect campaign and promote the same ethos and ethics as shown below.

We expect, every person, whether player, official or supporter to conduct themselves in an exemplary manner. Players are expected to play the game in accordance with the spirit of the Laws, to accept all decisions without question and to be a credit to the Club whether at 'Home' or 'Away'. Please be aware that the Club is responsible for the conduct of supporters who should therefore follow the same principals.

The use of foul or abusive language or the showing of dissent, whether by word or action, is not acceptable to the Club. In addition to any punitive measures imposed by the Governing Body, the management of the Club reserves the right to take its own additional measures against persistent or serious offenders.

Any Club member (which includes for the avoidance of doubt all players and their parents, guardians and supporters) who is the subject of disciplinary action, which includes any financial penalty, undertakes to reimburse the Club in full any monies which may be paid on their behalf. The Club will support any member if it considers that the disciplinary action is unjustified.

All kit and equipment remains the property of the Club, whether be supplied by TFC or through parent / team sponsorship and once a badge with the club logo is on it, becomes the property of the club and must be returned on leaving the club. Non-return contravenes club rules and will lead to the player's registration being suspended and / or the player may not be able to play for another club in the MMYL or any other league until resolved.

TFC implement the RESPECT Campaign and as a member of this Club I agree to abide by the rules/regulations set down by the RESPECT Campaign.

Membership of the Club is consequent upon any person's unreserved acceptance of this Code.

Spectators and Parents/Carers

Play your part and support The FA's Code of Respect:

- Have fun; it's what we're all here for!

 - Always respect the Referee and coaches and encourage players to do the same
 - Stay behind the touchline and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided)
 - When players make mistakes, offer them encouragement to try again next time
 - Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- I understand that if I do not follow the Code, I may be:**
- Issued with a verbal warning or asked to leave
 - Required to meet with the club committee, league or CFA Welfare Officer
 - Obligated to undertake an FA education course
 - Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have my membership removed
 - Required to leave the club along with any dependents and/or issued a fine
