

TFC TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT POLICY

- TFC will provide facilities for training once a week during the playing season, extra sessions are to be paid for by the squads themselves but the Site Liaison person must be informed immediately if this session is not going to be used who will contact other managers offering that training slot
- Continual misuse of any of the training facilities provided may result in that squad losing the right to use it.
- At least ONE representative of each squad's Management team MUST be minimum FA Level 1 qualified; CRB checked and attended the required workshops.
- All new Managers or Coaches must be booked on the FA level 1 course within two months of starting to manage a team and attended the required workshop within the timescale allowed by the FA.
- All qualifications must be kept up to date.
- Courses booked for Managers & Coaches when appropriate for the clubs best interest will be paid for by the club and discussed at the main committee meeting before action is taken.
- Failure to attend will result in the committee requesting payment.
- Of those courses, if a replacement candidate cannot be found, in case of emergency the Secretary, Chairman and Treasurer will make a decision on behalf of the club and report back to the main committee.
- It is the responsibility of the Parent/Carer to ensure any player attending events is suitably dressed for the occasion to ensure the safety of him/her and others and to provide a drink at all matches and training sessions.
- It is the responsibility of the Manager and Coaches to ensure that this request is being followed before the sessions/matches commence.
- A Development officer to be appointed to organise mentoring /refresher training for club coaches/managers
