Do:

- © Arrive promptly for training sessions & sign the register
- © Listen to the Coaches: they are giving up their time for <u>your</u> benefit
- Pay subscriptions & match fees promptly
- © Tell your Coach ASAP if you cannot play in a match

Do Not:

- Play with hockey sticks/balls either when coaches are not present, or when told not to
- (a) Argue with the Umpire's decision, even if you think it is wrong
- Smoke, consume alcohol or illegal drugs on club premises or whilst representing the Club
- Swear at, threaten or persistently tease anyone

Anyone who breaks the rules will be warned verbally, in writing and then suspended or expelled at the discretion of the Club Committee. DSHC reserves the right to terminate the membership for gross misconduct.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS

DSHC fully welcomes the support and involvement of parents/carers in their son's/daughter's Hockey. Please help us by adhering to a few guidelines:

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.

- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Parents/Carers MUST accompany their children to the playing area or club house and ensure that the Coach(es) and/or Official(s) are present and MUST collect their child/children at the end of the session at the arranged time from the playing area or club house.
- When spectating, please consider your conduct and the impact on the young players.
