



## COVID—19: Tier 3 Matrix of permitted activities

Following the announcement Nottinghamshire will be entering Tier 3, we have created this Matrix to help members understand what is permitted under these restrictions. This is in addition to complying with Government & RFU requirements.

The Rule of 6 applies and the clubhouse is only open for use of toilets.
