# **Format of the Day**



## Under 7's / 8's

Each age group will play matches on a 5-a-side basis

As per FA rules (and as directed by Lincolnshire FA) these age groups will be played on a non-competitive basis, and no results will be recorded. All players in the two age groups will receive a participation medal after all the matches have been concluded

## <u>Under 9's / 10's / U11's / U12's</u>

Each age group will play matches on a 7-a-side basis

There will be two groups of five teams with teams playing each other once. The winners and runners up from both groups will proceed onto a semi final knockout basis. 3 points are to be awarded for a win, and 1 point will be awarded for a drawn match.

In the event of teams having identical points totals after all group matches have been completed, the basis on which they will be separated will be as follows:-

- 1. Goal Difference
- 2. Goals Scored
- 3. Head to Head record (should more than 2 teams be involved, then matches will form a mini group..)
- 4. Should there be no means of separation, then a 5min play off will be played

## Semi-Finals & Finals

Should any of these matches finish as a draw after normal time, the tie will proceed straight to a penalty shootout. 5 players who were on the field of play at the final whistle will take penalties (if scores are level then sudden death will decide the tie, with the same 5 players going in rotation...)

The winning team will receive a trophy and individual medals, and the runners up will also receive medals

## The following laws of the game are to followed during the tournament...

- 1. The field of play will be as appropriate for the age groups playing
- 2. The penalty area will be marked as appropriate
- 3. An unlimited amount of players are allowed in the penalty area
- 4. Goal-Keepers can come out of the penalty area
- 5. A goalkeeper can handle the ball anywhere in the penalty area, and have unlimited steps whilst the ball is in their hands (however the 6 second rule will apply...)
- 6. Throw-ins and corners are as per FA rules for 11-a-side football
- 7. Players ARE NOT allowed to throw back or pass back to the goalkeeper if the goalkeeper was to collect the ball in their hands
- 8. The offside rule does not apply
- 9. ALL free kicks are to be direct
- 10. At free kicks opposing players must be at least 2 metres away from the ball

In addition to the above, the following will also apply at the Deeping Tournament...

- 1. Age Group bandings are as per the Peterborough Junior Alliance League for the 2020-21 season
- 2. ALL goalkeepers are not allowed to kick from their hands (distribution must be thrown out...)
- 3. The "Goal Kick Retreat" rule will apply to the U7's / U8's only
- 4. Each team listed first in the fixtures will provide the match ball
- 5. All teams must have a first aid kit present
- 6. A team can register a maximum of 10 players per team
- 7. Substitutions can be on a rolling basis, and must take place at the half way line
- 8. Shin guards must be worn by ALL participating players
- 9. Shirts must be worn inside shorts during games
- 10. In the event of a colour clash, the team listed first will provide a change of shirt or wear bibs
- 11. Only designated officials are allowed on the field of play. ALL spectators must remain behind the barriers at all times
- 12. 2 yellow cards in consecutive games will result in a 1 match game ban
- 13. A red card in any game will result in that player not having any further part in the tournament
- 14. In all matters regarding the laws of the game, the referee's decision is final
- 15. Where a club has more than one team entered into an age group, a player can only play for one team throughout the tournament.
- 16. In all matters regarding the rules of the tournament, the organising committee's decision is final
- 17. Abuse of any kind towards an official or ANY player will not be tolerated
- 18. Fair Play and Goodwill should be demonstrated at all times by players / officials & spectators
