CB Hounslow United F.C is a Football club based in the London Borough of Hounslow. The team was originally named Richmond Rangers, and was a collection of friends and local troubled youth that where losing their path in life.

In season 1987/88 Richmond Rangers where disbanded and reformed in 1988/89 under the name of CB united.

CB Hounslow United FC carry the community flag for football and support in Hounslow, since the demise of the historic Hounslow FC which was formed in 1884. Community support is the essence of what we do as a club.

Currently the club supports Promise Academy for 16 to 18 year olds. With a sports and educational programme. Promise Academy Mini Kickers and OHM Sports Mini Kickers

CB stands for 'Cater Bank' which was the company co-owned by the late father of our Chairman/founder Frank James. CB Hounslow played in the Hounslow & District Football League with some distinction, and after 5 successful years we were promoted to the Middlesex county Football League (MCFL) in 1994/95 that is when we then took our present name CB Hounslow United. The club still have 3 sides that play in the MCFL and the 1st team playing in the Premier of Combined Counties FL @ Step 5.

CB Hounslow United 1st team played for 11 years in the MCFL before being promoted to the Combined Counties in 2005/6 season. The club is now affiliated to the Combined Counties League, Middlesex County FL, West Middlesex Sunday League, Allied Counties Youth League, Surrey Youth League, West Middlesex Youth League and Harrow Youth League and Greater London Womens league.

This season and going forward the club has now a Patron: Mr Max Lea MBE a stalwart in football, who come up through the referee ranks and played football for Old Parmiterians Football Club. His support to Club is hugely appreciated and can only benefit the club going forward.

Also Frank the owner of CB has handed the reigns over to Mr Dave Fuller who will become the Chairman of the board and handle non on the pitch matters for the club. Allowing Frank to concentrate on just football matters as he enjoys running a team. Dave comes with a huge amount of experience. He is a MCFA Councillor and has officiated in Middlesex for over 50 years and CB itself for 20 years.

The History of Tadley Calleva FC

Tadley has had a football team since the early 1900's. In the modern era the team was re-formed in 1989 and played in the Basingstoke and North Hants Leagues before winning promotion to the Hampshire League. The club was formed as Tadley F.C. in 1989. They joined the Hampshire League Division Three in 1994, finishing runners-up in 1995–96, gaining promotion to Division Two. The club changed its name to Tadley Town F.C. in 1999 and joined Division One upon reorganisation. In 2004, they changed their name to their present name and entered the Wessex Football League Division Three.

Division Three was re-named Division Two in 2006, and the club finished runners-up in 2007. In the 2007–08 season, they won the Wessex League Division One title but were denied promotion as their ground did not meet the requirements for the Premier Division. The Reserve side was also highly successful in the same season by taking the Wessex Combination League title.

Since then the team has remained in Division One and has steadily been making progress on and off the field year on year. They narrowly missed out on promotion in 2014-15 and 2015-16 respectively by finishing in 3rd position in both seasons.

In the 2010–11 campaign they reached the final of the Basingstoke Senior Cup losing to Thatcham Town 4–1. The club then went on to win the same cup in 2013-14 beating local rivals AFC Aldermaston 3-2 (aet) in the final. In September 2014, the club recorded probably the best result of its modern history, defeating Conference South Basingstoke Town on penalties in the Hampshire FA Senior Cup at The Camrose after a 2-2 draw in 90 minutes.

The club had its best run in the FA Vase in season 2015-16 reaching the 3rd round proper before eventually being knocked out 4-2 after a replay and extra-time against Newport (IoW) from the Wessex Premier Division.

They have also reached the final of the North Hants Senior Cup in the last two seasons; losing out 3-1 to local rivals Whitchurch United in 2016-17, again at The Camrose, and then 5-4 on penalties to Andover New Street in 2017-18 at Longmeadow after a 3-3 draw in normal time.

The club achieved its ambition of gaining promotion to the Wessex League Premier Division in 2018-19 season - the highest level (Step 5) that the club has competed at. The goal is to consolidate its position on the field and to make significant progress with the infrastructure off the field. Tadley finished 8th in their first season.

Tadley were lying 13th after 28 games in season in 2019-20. The season finished in March due to Coronavirus.

In 2020-21 Tadley had a change in Secretary, after many years Dean Newton step down. The club would like to place on record are thanks for the work and time put in by Dean. Wayne Chivers stepped as temporary secretary. After no one come forward, Wayne Chivers took it up on a full time basis.

In 2020/21 Tadley had there best run in the FA cup in the club's history, team manager Adam Clarke saw the club reach the First qualifying round.

In 2021/22 Tadley Calleva has seen a chance in league and management, the club has joined the combined counties league. This was due to the FA restructuring at Steps 4-6. Adam Clarke had to step down due to work commitments, we wished Adam the best of luck. Gareth Thomas was named first team manager for the coming season. We all at Tadley Calleva are looking forward to the new challenges we have for the coming season.
