CB Hounslow United F.C is a Football club based in the London Borough of Hounslow. The team was originally named Richmond Rangers, and was a collection of friends and local troubled youth that where losing their path in life.

In season 1987/88 Richmond Rangers where disbanded and reformed in 1988/89 under the name of CB united.

CB Hounslow United FC carry the community flag for football and support in Hounslow, since the demise of the historic Hounslow FC which was formed in 1884. Community support is the essence of what we do as a club.

Currently the club supports Promise Academy for 16 to 18 year olds. With a sports and educational programme. We currently run our own mini kickers programme midweek and support Promise coaching on Saturdays

CB stands for 'Cater Bank' which was the company co-owned by the late father of our Chairman/founder Frank James. CB Hounslow played in the Hounslow & District Football League with some distinction, and after 5 successful years we were promoted to the Middlesex county Football League (MCFL) in 1994/95 that is when we then took our present name CB Hounslow United. The club still have 3 sides that play in the MCFL and the 1st team playing in the Premier of Combined Counties FL @ Step 5.

CB Hounslow United 1st team played for 11 years in the MCFL before being promoted to the Combined Counties in 2005/6 season. The club is now affiliated to the Combined Counties League, Middlesex County FL, West Middlesex Sunday League, Allied Counties Youth League, Surrey Youth League, West Middlesex Youth League and Harrow Youth League and Greater London Womens league.

Club has now a Patron: Mr Max Lea MBE a stalwart in football, who come up through the referee ranks and played football for Old Parmeritians Football Club. His support to Club is hugely appreciated and can only benefit the club going forward.

Also Frank the owner of CB has handed the reigns over to Mr Dave Fuller who will become the Chairman of the board and handle non on the pitch matters for the club. Allowing Frank to concentrate on just football matters as he enjoys running a team. Dave comes with a huge amount of experience. He is a MCFA Councillor and has officiated in Middlesex for over 50 years and CB itself for 20 years.

We are also with the success of our 2 ladies sides we are starting on developing our Wildcats from U10, u12, u14, u16

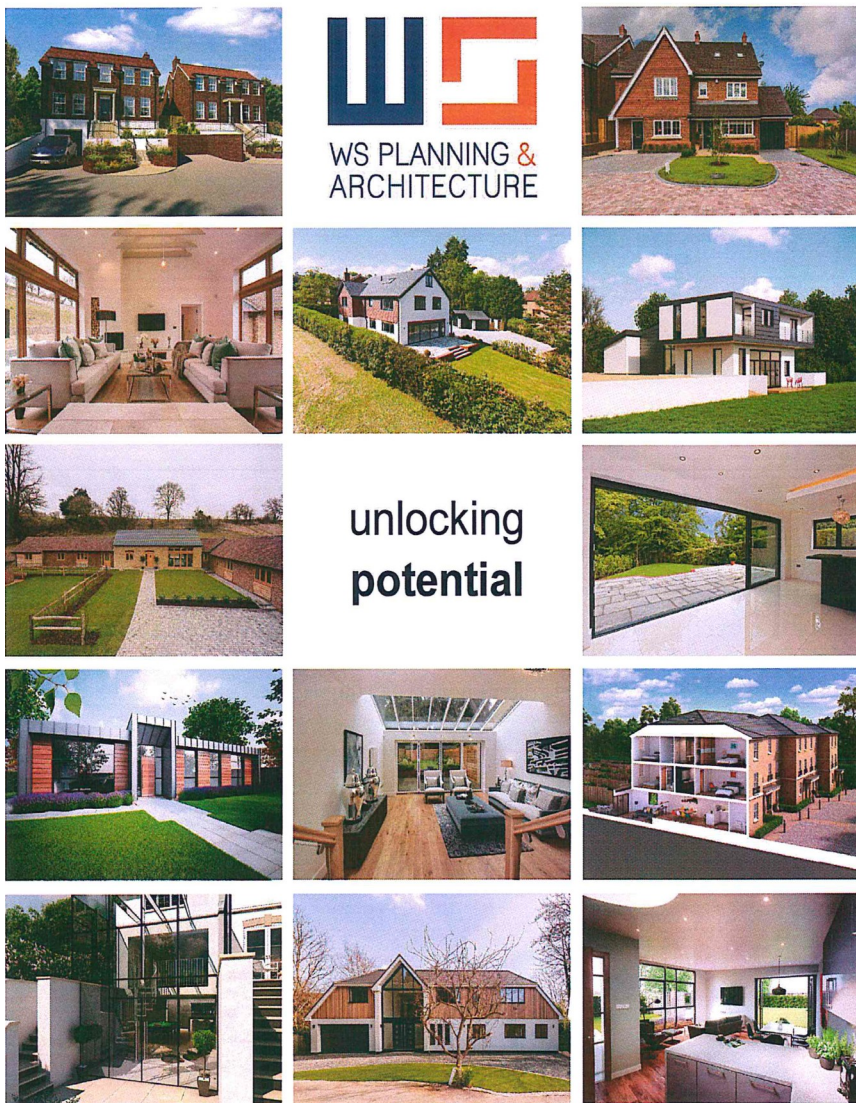

A BRIEF HISTORY OF BURNHAM FOOTBALL CLUB

Founded in 1878, [Burnham Football Club](#) is the second oldest club Buckinghamshire. We played in the early years, with considerable success, in various leagues, before joining the Great Western Combination in 1948.

We moved to the Wycombe Combination in 1964 and then spent one season (1970/71) in the Reading Combination. In 1971 the club was elected to the Hellenic League. Winning both the Premier Division and League Cup in 1975/76. We were also twice beaten finalists in the League Cup too.

In 1977 the club were elected to the Athenian League and were twice runners-up before the league folded in 1984.

We competed in the London Spartan League in 1984/85. Winning both the Premier Division title and the League Cup.

The summer of 1985 bought about the amalgamation of the football club with Hillingdon Borough FC, who had lost their ground and were about to fold.

We played in the Southern League as Burnham & Hillingdon FC and reverted back to the former name of Burnham FC in 1987. Season 1994/95 saw us finish bottom. Resulting in relegation to the Hellenic League.

After 3 seasons in the Hellenic League, finishing fifth, third and again third in 1998/99. the club won both the Premier Division title and the League Cup. Therefore, gaining promotion back to the Southern Football League where we have played ever since.

The 2006/07 season saw us achieve our highest league position. Finishing 3rd and thus qualifying for the end of season Promotion Play-Off semi final. Unfortunately losing to the eventual winners – Swindon Supermarine.

The 2012-2013 season was, without doubt, the most successful in the football clubs history. The First Team won the Evo Stik League Southern Division One Central (Southern League) championship. Earning promotion to the newly sponsored Calor League Premier Division (Southern League), while our Reserves won the UHLSPORT Hellenic League Division Two East championship at the first time of asking. Earning promotion to Division One East where they came up against the First Teams of many of the previous seasons opposition.

CUP COMPETITION HISTORY

In cup competitions Burnham reached the Quarter Final of the FA Vase in 1977/78 and then went one better in reaching the Semi Final in 1982/83. Losing 4-2 over two legs to Halesowen Town. The clubs record attendance of 2400 was achieved in the home leg.

We have twice reached the Third Qualifying round of the FA Cup and in 2005/06 we reached the First Round Proper for the first time ever, before losing at home to Aldershot Town.

In the F.A.Trophy we reached the Fourth Round (the last 16) in 1999/2000. Before losing to Scarborough in a replay after a creditable 1-1 draw at The Gore. In the Berks & Bucks Senior Cup we reached the Semi Final twice before losing on both occasions to Chesham United.

AND NOW... 2021

Burnham FC now play in the Cherry Red Records Combined Counties [Premier League North](#).

The renamed 1878 stadium and its facilities have undergone a major refurbishment programme over the last 12 months. Providing the board with the chance to achieve one of their key objectives of building closer links with local clubs and the local community. In particular [Burnham Juniors](#) now enjoy the opportunity of both playing matches and training on the new football pitch together with other local football clubs, including [Chalvey Sports FC](#) who will play their home games for the 2021/22 season here, and [Britwell FC](#) who will also play some Friday night home games on the new pitch.
