COACHING TIMES

Sunday's (all age groups)

With so many players now involved please try and arrive ready to sign in from 10.50am at the administration desk. Please try to arrive promptly to enable sessions to start on time.

Parents and players are also reminded that if playing in tournaments on a Sunday should not attend Sunday training as well. Older players involved in matches may be required to attend training and coaches will confirm.

Green Pitch

Cubs: (from age 5) 11.00 - 12noon

Rabbits & Otters: 11.00 - 12.30

Blue Pitch

Under 14's & Under 16's boys and girls: 11.00 – 12.30

Sessions for the older groups do not include a planned break. Players must bring a water bottle / drink with them to have pitch side. Coaches may decide to have short break depending on the weather.

Tuesday's (blue pitch)

School years 7 – 9 (boys & girls):

18:30 - 19:30

School years 9 - 11 (boys & girls)

19:00 - 20:00

Players arriving for the 7.00pm session must wait in the clubhouse and not warm up on the pitch until their allocated time.

Players are not supervised before 7.00pm and they must regard the safety of younger players on the pitch and respect their pitch time / space allocated to the year 7 - 9 group.

TEAMS AND MATCHES

With so many players across all age groups coaches and managers are working through ensuring as many players as possible are invited to play in tournaments or matches.

The majority of our teams use an on line team management tool call Teamer (www.teamer.net). For parents/ players this is a free service and can be used on line or via a downloadable App

We have over 50 players in years 7 – 9 and this is creating a challenge for coaches to manage balancing fielding a team with structure and experience and giving new players an opportunity to play 11 a side hockey on a Saturday. PLAYER / SPECTATORS CONDUCT

It is fantastic to see so many young players now taking the opportunity to come along and watch wither academy or senior hockey before they train or play – or just when visiting the club.

We want to encourage Academy players to take an active interest in watching hockey and enjoy their time at the club.

We do need to reinforce to parents and players a **few basic rules and courtesy's** and would ask parents to support the Academy in endorsing these!

- Parents are responsible for academy players when they are not in formal coaching or matches. The academy are not responsible for supervision
- Academy players must not play (with a stick / ball) on the side of either pitch when matches are being played or training is taking place. This is both dangerous and disrespectful to those playing and distracting
- When spectating players / parents need to pay attention to the play to avoid injury and stand on the side lines not behind the goal or back line.

WEATHER & PITCHES!!

As the weather starts to get chillier parents should be aware of arrangements for cancellation. We rarely have to cancel training and matches due to weather main reasons are frozen pitches and snow.

This season we will be using the new website and twitter to provide updates and if in doubt parents should check before they set off. No message means the pitches are fit!
