### Project 18, One step closer....

If you've seen our posts on social media over the last few days, then you'll already know that the club was awarded a £50,000 grant from the National Hockey Foundation towards the cost of re-surfacing the Green pitch. The focus of the award recognises our commitment to community team and Academy Hockey but also means that Junior Football, Junior Cricket and Lacrosse would benefit from a new playing surface.



This is obviously a BIG building block in our long term plans set out in 'Project 18', that eventually will see an extension to the clubhouse, new entrance and driveway configuration and then a similar refurbishment of the blue pitch. We appreciate the irony of the current situation with no community sport for any of us to enjoy, but we remain fixed on the positive horizon ahead and know that it will return soon.

Our focus now shifts to the tender returns which are due in the middle of May. If these come in around the right price, then the prospect of overhauling the green pitch this summer suddenly becomes a real possibility. The award matches other grant support we have already secured and whilst we are getting closer, we are pretty certain that there will still be a funding gap we will have to bridge if the TSC Board are to give the go ahead in the light of the current lockdown and disappearance overnight of 99% of our revenue.

We are currently working on a fundraising strategy to address any shortfall, as soon as the tender returns are in. Whilst this award is great news for YOUR club, we're pretty sure that there still be a need for a final fundraising push to get this over the line and we hope to be able to present our ideas for this very soon....

## **Ongoing maintenance**

The outfield has now been vertidrained, re-seeded and fertilised. Goals mouth areas have been repaired. The pot-holes down the main driveway have been filled in and we are soon to re-paint the yellow lines and parking bays. Repairs to the Wood Lane wall are planned for

next week. We are also working our way through our Health and Safety policies, updating and hopefully setting out a better way of doing things.





# No increase in annual subscriptions...

At this time of year, we would be agreeing our annual subscriptions for 2020-21. However, the closure of the clubhouse and suspension of all sport has complicated those discussions. The TSC Board have had to weigh up the current financial and operational situation with the longer term by continuing to invest in our facilities as a critical factor in the club reestablishment when we eventually come out of lockdown.

Consequently, the TSC Board have agreed to maintain the subscriptions at the current level, and for the third season in a row, from 1/4/20 through to 31/3/2.

Details will soon be on the clubs website and will be circulated by all sections but the main headlines are that Senior playing subs will be £170, concessions £85 and under 18s £65. However, during the current lockdown, the Board has exceptionally agreed the following will apply:

- All members are encouraged to pay their 2020-21 subs where possible by the due dates or early for winter sports to support the Club through this period. The Hockey, Lacrosse and Football sections will be updating members soon about options for payment.
- Special arrangements have been put in place for Cricket to reflect the impact on the 2020 playing season.
  - Payment of subscriptions for under 18 Cricket players will be suspended until such time that it is clear if any of the 2020 season can be played. Players will remain members.
  - All other Cricket members to be encouraged to make a partial payment of £53 (or 50% of the concessions sub if applicable) by 31<sup>st</sup> May 2020 towards their subscription (equivalent of a full non-playing member). Any additional monies due will be determined once more is known. This will retain membership of TSC Ltd, voting and participation.

In the context of the above proposed investment in the green pitch which in turn benefits every member of the club, we would ask for your support and help by paying your subscriptions early or on time.

Everything remains under review and as we learn more about the gradual lifting of restrictions on social distancing and community sport, all of our section chairs are working together to actively explore how and when we can sensibly begin to re-start the club and open up our facilities.

### Keep jogging, walking and cycling by....

If you are out and about, taking in your daily exercise, there is something you can do to help us. Take a stroll by the club, just keep an eye open for anything unusual. If you see anything that doesn't seem quite right, get in touch via social media or direct.

We know many of you are already doing this - thanks for that – it all helps.

#### **Bob Watkin.**

We must also record the passing of one of our Honorary Life Member's, Bob Watkin. Although he was both Secretary and Match Secretary of the Cricket Section during the 70s, It is perhaps as a long standing Umpire that has been recalled by most of his colleagues form that time. Before neutral umpires were 'appointed' by the league, Bob had a reputation through the Cheshire cricket fraternity for enduring fairness and integrity for many seasons. He was one of those ever-present club members who could always be relied upon to undertake whatever task was required or requested.

#### Wyn Williams.

As a cricketer, Wyn scored 2,500+ runs in a playing career of over twenty seasons starting in 1966, scoring two centuries & at least four 50's. He was a successful 2<sup>nd</sup> XI Captain in the 1975 & 1976 seasons and again in 86 & 87, and in cases, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Xi finished in the top six. On hearing the news of his passing, several members have commented that Wyn made a real effort to make new members welcome and was an active member of the Cricket section during that time. Most recently, as a Vice President of the Cricket Section Wyn and his wife, Betty were regular attendee's at our annual dinner.

Again, we send a shout out to our club-mates who are working in the front line within the NHS and all those members and former members working in essential roles to help support our communities at this time. We thank them all for the essential work they are doing and look forward to happier times ahead.
