# One Club ... Four Sports... and new challenges ahead ...

September is a busy time in the club calendar with all four sports playing alongside each other as we cross over from cricket to football, hockey and lacrosse. It will be great to see lots of old and new faces back at the club, playing, training, volunteering, spectating and enjoying the bar and hopefully the autumn sun. It does mean we'll be very busy so please do you bit and if you live locally walk or cycle to club, or car share if possible.

## A sustainable future for TSC

In August one of our two main water heaters failed and a repair does not seem to be a possibility. Initial quotes to replace like with like ran into five figures and it prompted us to look at other options. Led by Mike Welton and John McGuire (Hockey section Vice President and former player), we are looking at our overall approach to sustainability in general and heating in particular.

We've commissioned a review of the opportunities open to us linked to building repairs needed in the short and longer term with the intention of balancing cost with environmental concerns. Replacing the clubs water heating system is going to be a major undertaking and its perhaps easy to appreciate how such a visible and costly project will affect other projects and priorities. We'll be sharing the results of the review in the coming weeks and planning accordingly.

Equally, we are trying to reduce the amount of waste we produce. Mike and our Bar Manager, Jane have worked over the summer to introduce reusable plastic glasses for outdoor use and we've had positive feedback from members about the reduction in single use plastics. But of course, this approach is only viable if member and visitors do their bit too and return the reusable plastic glasses to the bar or the collection points and don't throw them in the bin!

# **Decking / The Great Timperley Auction 2022**

In Bluesletter#13, (April 2022) we had a plan to replace the decking this autumn. Unfortunately, due to complications around the grant and planning permission that is not going to be possible and we are now looking towards Mar/April next year as a more practical solution. Disappointing but we have to move on. In the next week or two, we'll be undertaking the necessary repairs to get us through the winter.

Despite the above setback, the decking remains a priority and every £ raised will be ringfenced for its replacement. The auction is a great way to raise additional funds and something through which every member can contribute by either, donating an auction 'lot', bidding when the auction goes live or telling you friends, work colleagues or promoting it through your own social media accounts. **The auction is not just for club members.**

The new system has bedded in well for cricket with queries arising. Thanks also to our Non Playing members for getting their Subs paid.

We now move on to collecting annual TSC subs and section fees for Football, Hockey and Lacrosse – the deadline for payment is 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022 – or if you're wishing to pay by instalments initial payments must have been set up by 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2022.

We're working through the outstanding queries – primarily triggered by the early payments and cross over on system dates. We will aim to clear these by mid September.

- Check all your personal details are correct
- Click on 'Buy Membership' and select the membership type you want to pay for
- Click the GIFT AID OPT IN available on all U18 memberships if you are able to support the club in this way (Gift Aid reclaimed funds go back to each section to invest back into their sports)

## For first time members or those who didn't play TSC Subs via the FSI system last year:

- Go to <a href="https://timperley.first-sports.com/">https://timperley.first-sports.com/</a> and log into your account
- Click on 'GET STARTED' to open an account (to be completed by parents for all U18)
- Set up your account and click on the validation email you will receive
- Parents if u18's can then 'add family members' to their account for any U18's
- once your account is set up click on 'BUY MEMBERSHIP' and select the membership type you want to pay for
- Click the GIFT AID OPT IN available on all U18 memberships if you are able to support the club in this way (Gift Aid reclaimed funds go back to each section to invest back into their sports)

#### Member cashless cards

If you log into your TSC Account on the FSI system members aged 18+ will be able to see your 'Cardless Account' showing a barcode, balance and transactions. The Cashless Account (and Barcode) replaces the old plastic bar cards – if you have an old plastic card this can still be used but if not the new system works by showing the barcode on your phone.

Access your accounts and cashless bar code on your phone. You can then add credit to your cashless balance at the bar (by CC or DR card or cash. For eligible bar purchases you'll receive a 10% discount when you use the cashless bar code on your phone (or old card).

New sign ups to the FSI system will be contacted once their membership is approved with details to confirm that their cashless account has been set up.

We have been selected one of 17 Hockey Club's by England Hockey to run and host one of EH's new Regional 'Talent Academies' that will provide the best development and training opportunities to develop young athletes with high potential in the 15 - 18 year old and feed into the U16 and U18 national age group teams and identifying future senior international players. This is a major strategic step for THC and Open Trials (through an EH nominations process) start on 4th September with over 180 boys and girls attending assessment sessions the Club aiming to be selected for the 24 places per gender. The Talent Academy will train on a Monday evening (7pm to 9pm) and will be competing with other TA's during the season. Rob Turner is Head Coach for the Boys, Zoe Sinclair Girls Head Coach and Caroline Small is the TA Manager.

Our volunteers are now gearing up for the new season and big thanks as ever to everyone involved in #MakingHockeyHappen at Timperley for so many. A special shout out for Emma Bartlett (Ladies 2's) who took her volunteering to a new level as a Commonwealth Games in Birmingham. Emma was

- Brooklands Junior Football Club had initiated a conversation with the then, Exec Committee
  about moving their base to Timperley Sports Club. Initial discussion were thought to be very

  were to change their name to Timperley FC and a few years later, a fully committed sporting
  section of TSC].
