Well first of all – a belated Happy New Year to you all. With a quick look back to December I'd also like to say Congratulations to Cath Wemyss and Caroline Small re the birth of Jessica Rose and secondly a well done to Sophie Robinson for being one of the major winners in the Club Christmas Raffle .

How are we doing?

After what always seemed like quite a long break for Christmas and New Year, we've made a really good start

- Good numbers for Wed training
- 1s top North Prem with a couple of tough double header weekends and are now on 12 back to back wins
- 3s are 2nd in Cheshire Div 3 keeping hold of that key second promotion slot keeping us on course with our strategy

Availability

On paper all the teams have lots of players available to play. To help the captains and coaches in selection planning it really helps if you tell us

- When you are not available at all
- What dates you have constraints eg due to work, family commitments, school commitments etc

Please review and let your captain or myself know of any unavailability that you know of now and keep us updated as the season progresses. It saves a lot of messing about rather than us selecting people and then getting messages of "of sorry I'm not available" and having to re-select and move people up/down sides late in the week. This is particularly important lower down the sides where if everyone is available we operate on a rotation basis.

Money!

Although we are officially one section following the merger, each area (Mens, Ladies, Academy) is still responsible for "their" part of the existing (2015-16) season's expenses and income that we had each planned prior to the merger.

For the Ladies **the Bonus Ball** is one of the regular was of raising money – in case you don't know....each Saturday we sell 59 numbers (£1 a number) corresponding to the lottery numbers. The person who bought the number corresponding to the Lotto Bonus Ball each wins £30 and the Ladies retain the other £29 (if we sell them all). If we sell all 59 every league Saturday we'd raise £638 – a not insignificant amount.

Each team playing at Home is responsible for helping sell the Bonus Ball sheet that week — so please play your part and volunteer to help out — the Captains will be looking for your help as they have plenty of others things to sort out on match days

The 200 Club - If you haven't heard of this before — this is a Club fundraiser -£4 a month buys you a number in the monthly draw. It's payable by Standing Order and again helps create a steady income stream to the club

Training

Thanks to Mike and Jamie getting the section back into training on Wednesday – hopefully not too much of a shock to the system! Please ensure we support training – the results and league positions bear out that good training attendance gets results on a Saturday and lets us work on things as teams.

As you may have noticed we have made some adjustments to the start time of the earlier slot. We have taken on board feedback about the start time of 7pm being too early and have made some adjustment. This of course has a knock on effect on the other slot in terms of pitch availability but we hope that this will help people getting to the first slot by giving a bit more time.

On the third Wednesday of the month it was agreed core 4th team players can also stay on to the later slot to help development (note –we will take guidance from coaches on that slot)

And finally keep training, keep fit, keep winning!
