The North West held it's inaugural AGM on 14th July 2021, with in excess of 70 attending.

The 8 Area's are: North West, Yorkshire & North East, Midlands, London, East, South East, South Central and West. We are registered with Companies House - <u>Company Number 13433627</u>

North West Hockey brings together different leagues and organisations from within the North West Area with the aim to provide the best possible hockey experience for all existing participants, from players and clubs to volunteers, officials and those new to hockey. We've a team of 54 volunteers involved in the new Area across all our committee's and thank everyone who has stepped up to take on the new role and join our committees. We will be working closely with clubs, schools, local organisations and our three County hockey association's, to continue to develop and grow the sport by offering a wide range of opportunities to play hockey, opening up the sport to all.

Ensuring everyone has access to our activities and will be able to participate on and off the field will be the cornerstone of our success.

From August 2021 in the North West Hockey Area we will be offering:

- Adult Leagues & Competitions
- Junior Leagues & Competitions
- Schools Competitions
- Masters Leagues & Competitions

Welcome from the NWH Junior Committee! You might notice some changes for the coming season, it's a really exciting time, aiming to give more young people the opportunity to play more hockey and at the right level.

This committee will:

Manage Area Tier 1 and Tier 2 league activity from U14 - U18's, Deliver Area finals for U10/12 IN2 Hockey Champs Deliver Tier 3 competitions,
Support the School and indoor comps where needed.

The competitions for new and developing teams and 1st round of IN2 will be administered through your County hockey organisations, hopefully you'll be hearing from them soon.

Adults Section

The proposed start of the Adult League is 25th September 2021. The <u>fixtures</u> can be found on the England Hockey website.

The Competitions Management System (CMS) will be renamed Game Management System (GMS), this is where Clubs and teams will enter their details. An important part of this system is that every player will need to register on the system and this will form the basis for online team sheets for every game. This player registration will ensure that a fair selection policy is maintained, guided by the League Regulations, and a transfer process if players wish to move clubs. Please could all Clubs sign up for the GMS training which should be available in the coming weeks.

The League Regulations referred to above are in the final stages of approval and will be issued shortly.

The Adult League and Competitions Committee is chaired by Leighan Bleasdale (adultleaguechair@northwesthockey.co.uk) as elected at the North West AGM. The Area League Manager is Peter McInulty and the Assistant Area League Manager is Louise Broome. Each League will have a Divisional Coordinator, details of the full Adult League & Competitions Committee will be shared to all Clubs shortly.

OFFICIATING

The N W H Area Officiating Committee is responsible for managing and administering Umpiring and Technical Officiating.

The remit is much broader than previously as in addition to recruiting, developing, and appointing neutral umpires and umpire coaches /assessors and young umpires we will also be working closely with Club Umpire Developers and Umpires to deliver the aims and objectives of England Hockey Officiating. In addition, we shall be aiming to provide more opportunities to develop technical officials

This is an exciting opportunity to support and improve officiating at all levels within the NW.

FINANCE

Welcome to the least exciting, but very essential part of North West Hockey Ltd.

As one of the 8 new Areas of England Hockey, our goal is to provide hockey at the lowest possible cost to the clubs.

The fees that we charge need to support the new systems being introduced such as Game Management System, Officiating Management System and Website in addition to the administrative and operational costs of the Area Committees (Adult Leagues, Junior Leagues, Officiating, Discipline and Masters). For the first season the cost of hockey to the clubs is: – Area Subscription £20/Adult Team and League Entry Fee £25/Adult League Team. There will be an announcement shortly on when these fees are due and method of payment. Niall Riley Finance Director

MASTERS

Participation in Masters hockey is considerably lower in the NW than in most of the rest of England - we've never had a Masters Committee for the North before, let alone the North West. Our first priority is to get more NW players involved, by

- a) creating the opportunity setting up open events for players of all ages from 34 upwards, men and women, around the North West early in the new season, and
- b) letting eligible players know, initially via clubs and personal contacts, then via the new EH player registration info, what's going on and inviting them (warmly!) to join in.

CLUB UMPIRING

Club umpires are the mainstay of officiating; without them club matches simply couldn't happen, they can make a big difference to the players enjoyment of the game and yet clubs are often struggling to find enough umpires. The AOC wants to help clubs attract more of their members into umpiring and to give them support so that they can develop their skills. The key is for clubs to have a Club Umpire Developer who focuses on developing umpires and N W Hockey will pay the fee of a club member who undertakes the online CUD course. To help CUD's in their role Cluster Leads will coordinate and support the activities in groups of clubs – Clusters. They are Chris Regan, Jane Evans, Luke Pibworth, Jo Skelton, Will Reynolds and Inge Bevers and they will soon be in contact if they have not already done so. In addition, NWH Facebook, and Twitter (see links) offer forums for information and discussion. Finally, a reminder that when the GMS comes onstream club umpires will need to register to enable the club to appoint them to games. Also, Clubs can take out the EHO Silver Membership package on behalf of their umpires and CUDs as this offers access to a greater range of support resources and materials.

DISCIPLINE

The transition to Area Discipline Administrator structure become effective on Sunday 1st Aug. In Simple terms Discipline below National League level is now dealt with across the whole area and not at county level however all the county discipline County DAs have moved across to become Assisted ADAs. This will lead to a shared workload but also all but the simplest matters will be looked at by a panel as opposed to an individual.

New regulations and accompanying forms are now on the EH website, only slight changes to do with the governance structure and removal of the need of the issuing umpire to categorise the offence.
