WHO ARE WE?

AFC (Amalgamated Football Club) Sudbury was formed on Tuesday 1st June 1999 from the amalgamation of Sudbury Town (founded 1885) and Sudbury Wanderers (founded 1958) making it then the newest senior club in East Anglia.

The first ever game was played at The Priory Stadium (the previous home of Town) on 17th July 1999 against a full Colchester United side in the Harwich Charity Cup Centenary Shield Semi-Final, and saw a 2-4 defeat after extra time in front of 397 spectators.

The club now plays at King's Marsh, Brundon Lane, Sudbury, which

Wanderers purchased in 1972 and were previously water meadows, from which two pitches and a training area were created. The clubhouse was opened in 1985 and the dressing rooms in 1991. Floodlights were added in 1992 and the following year a 200-seat



stand was built in addition to the two areas behind the goals being covered. In 2000 a new stand, 'The Shed', was opened and caters for 300 standing fans. In 2016 seating was added into The Shed stand as well.

AFC Sudbury's Academy was launched in 2015/16 and has very quickly become one of the best academy's in the region with numerous silverware in the trophy cabinet and players now studying in USA and playing professional football. AFC Sudbury Girls Academy was launched in 2019 and has proved an immensely popular option for girls interested in studying and playing sport post sixteen.

The AFC Sudbury Women's team has a rich and colourful history, the latest chapter of which begun in late 2018 following a restructure. Now under new leadership and guidance, the future of women's football in Suffolk looks very exciting at AFC Sudbury.



ACADEMY OVERVIEW

We are the only Football and Education Post 16 Scheme that provides the unique 'player performance pathway' where players are taught together, coached together and play together.

Every one of our coaches is also trained to degree level and therefore fulfills the role of coach and class teacher and instructor.

Our four Academy League Teams, AFC Sudbury Reserves, A, U19s and U18s only consist of players who are members of the Academy, we do not draw upon players who attend a different school or work or who plays for someone else. Similarly all our players only play for AFC Sudbury and no one else. We feel this is the only way to ensure your son develops alongside his peers and with the same coaches.

This may sound common but is unique in schemes such as this.

This unique program exposes our players to a high level of adult football from 16 years of age weekly in two leagues as well as regular age group football in our U18s and U19s. Because we do not balloon players in from outside the program a suitable volume of game time is available to maximise your two years with us.





AFC Sudbury Women made it two wins on the bounce as they ran out winners against Gorleston FC last Sunday, following on from their resounding 4-2 comeback victory against East Bergholt United the week before.

The 'Heath' was founded in the early years of 20th Century, around 1907-08. There's a bit of confusion as to our original colours as there are a few 'original' shirts still around including blue and gold stripes as well as black and old quarters. Since then we've changed a few times including green and gold quarters, green and white, blue and black stripes and lately yellow. This year we have gone back to our 60's colours of green and white.

We've had various 'homes' including somewhere close to the playing fields and also to the right of the old British Legion. We arrived at the 'Nest' around the time of the 2nd World War, when, after the chalk was quarried for the construction of various local roads, the land owner, Sir Charlton Briscoe, gave the quarry, also known as 'The Pit' to the village football club, on a long lease and in the mid 50's the brick stand was built. In the early 60's following Sir Charlton's passing, his son kindly offered the pit to the football club for a 'very small fee' which was gladly accepted and the place has grown since then.

From what little information is known about the club, we've not had a great deal of success over the years until fairly recently. We played in the Ouse Valley League in the early days and then the Essex and Suffolk Border league before becoming one of the founder members of the Norwich based Anglian Combination League in the early 60's, with our Reserve side playing in the Bury and District League. In the late 90's both sides joined the Cambs League were we have been until 2017-18 and indeed our Reserves side remain and are in Senior B. Most of our success has come in the last 20 years, although our 1st ever County success was in

1970 when we won the under 18's Suffolk Minor Cup. Our 1st Team won the Suffolk Junior Cup in the 70's and our Reserves also won back to back Suffolk Primary Cups in the early 90's.

The last ten years has seen the club establish itself in the upper echelons of Cambidgeshire football winning Senior A in 2008/9 and gaining promotion to Step 7. For the next 9 years we have finished in the top 3 of the Premier Division 6 times, winning the trophy in 2010/11. In 2015 our 1st Team won Suffolk Senior Cup with a record 7-0 score in the final against Ipswich Valley Rangers. I think we are among a handful of clubs that have won each of the County Cups available to us, maybe the only club!

The club appointed Ben Cowling as manager in the Spring of 2018 and he has overseen a dramatic overhaul of the clubs playing staff. On the pitch the clubs first ever season at Step 6 saw them finishing a creditable 5th place. One standout result was a league record away win when the club won 15-0 at Wisbech St Mary's.

2018-19 also saw a significant investment and improvement in the clubs facilities with Floodlights being installed at the ground for the first time, these were followed by new hard standing and dugouts as the club achieved a 'G' ground grading from the FA.

Other significant developments include the formation of the clubs U18 side who will compete in the Thurlow Nunn Midweek Youth League for the first time and the club will also make its debut in the FA Vase this coming season.

Tom Coombe (25), Tom is a recent signing from Fakenham Town, where he made a clean sweep of the players awards last season, he has also previously represented Walsham le Willows, Gorleston and Haverhill Rovers. A superb shot stopper with great hands he will undoubtedly quickly become a fans favourite.

Finlay Logan (22), A tenacious full back signed from Ely City where he had played for both the First team and the Reserves. Has fitted quickly into the team, is very good at defending 1 on 1 and likes to get forward as often as possible.

Tommy Hardwick (26), Tommy joined the club in the Autumn from Steeple Bumpstead in the Cambridgeshire League. Another very good defensive full back Tommy has won promotion from this division before with Haverhill Borough.

Tom Williams (26), Tom is a new signing, joining us from Ely City in December. A wholehearted defender with bags of experience and an eye for goal Tom will be a big boost to the group.

Ryan Geoghegan (26) A new arrival having signed in the summer from Premier Division Haverhill Rovers. Ryan is blessed with pace and is very good 1 v1, he will be looking to use his experience at this level and the one above to the clubs advantage.

Dean Grogan (22) Tenacious Centre half, who impressed the management with his desire to defend and will to win.

Dean arrived at the club in 2017 from Chatteris Town and has now established himself as the heartbeat of the team.

Sam Hawley (24) Sam begins his second season at the club and has been promoted to Captain of the side. Sam is very calm on the pitch and rarely gets booked despite being a CH or Holding CM by trade. Good range of passing and reads the game very well. An excellent addition to the squad and will often pop up with a vital goal or two.

Aaron Forshaw (25), Aaron joined the club in December 2018 from Haverhill Borough where he was Captain. A playmaker who often chips in with vital goals and very rarely loses possession Aaron is also not afraid to put a tackle in.

Reece Clarke (24) A classy playmaker, Reece has plenty of Thurlow Nunn experience at Steps 5&6 with Long Melford and Walsham Le Willows. Reece begins his second season with the club looking to drive the club forward.

Shane Leech (31) A tenacious midfielder who has links to the club going back many years having won the Suffolk Senior Cup with the club in 2016. Bags of energy and a desire to win make him an important asset to the club.

Kelvin Enaro (26), Kelvin begins his second season with the club as Vice-Captain having finished top scorer last season with 28 goals. Previous clubs include Newmarket, Mildenhall and Ely City. Quick and strong, Kelvin is a real fans favourite with his tricks and ability to take players on, certainly one to watch this year.

Ryan Weaver (26), Ryan rejoins the club following a brief spell at Haverhill rovers towards the end of last season. Able to operate through the middle or either wing Ryan brings

energy, desire and enthusiasm to the club and will form part of an exciting attack having scored 11 goals for the club last year.

Shaun Avis (27), Shaun re-joined the club from Newmarket Town in March last season and managed to score an impressive 15 goals in 8 games - having already scored 13 goals in the Premier Division. A predator in the box Shaun will be looking to fire the club to success. Very experienced player with former clubs including Mildenhall Town, Saffron Walden Town & Halstead Town.

Jack Gould (25), Jack has now made over 100 first team appearances for the club despite having seen last season ravaged by an ankle injury. Blessed with a very good left foot Jack has an excellent cross in his locker and the ability to score goals.

Rhys Mazey (20), A new signing, Rhys joins us from Ely City/Ely City Reserves. A versatile player with bags of energy who has impressed in pre season will look to make his mark on the team this year.
