Opportunity

We now need someone to lead our Communications program talking to our current club members and supporters, but also externally to the wider local and Rugby community.

The Role

To manage Manchester Rugby Club's external and internal communications in order to raise the club's media presence and profile both within the local community as the "go to club" as a player or parent, but also within the wider rugby community.

This position will be an integral part of the Rugby Committee

Candidate

Have a good knowledge of Social Media Platforms and scheduling posts. Creative, and able to use Canva to create content (training will be provided) Proactive in reacting to potential news stories

Responsibilities

In conjunction with Chairs of Rugby manage the social content across FB, Twitter and IG club platforms.

Work with Chairs of Rugby on consistent "look and feel" of club Social presence, whilst maintaining different section identities.

Create regular content for Club Website and social posts – Team Sheets, Try Scorers, Results, Fixture News, Player of Week, Club News etc....

Promotion of Fund Raising and Club Events

Work with Chair of Rugby on "more than just rugby" content for social media to create wider reach

Manage Match Day Program for 1XV games – 11 programs throughout the season – Work with printer to create program layout and content. Liaise with printer for printing and delivery.

Support

Committee members will provide constant support and input to help the candidate in their position. This is a volunteer role (as with all other Committee Roles), but budget can be allocated if required to pay for advertising, and or content as required.
