

## **Health & Safety Policy Statement**

Eton Manor RFC delivers a range of public events. They will ensure all internal and external service providers are responsible for implementing an event safety policy for all externally provided activities.

Eton Manor RFC will ensure so far as is reasonably practical, to identify and facilitate appropriate measures to maintain the health, safety and welfare of its employees and others during the event.

Eton Manor RFC recognises its duty to comply with the requirements of the Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 and any legislation made under it, in particular the management of Health & Safety at Work Regulations 1999.

Our policy is to comply with and where possible exceed the minimum number of requirements of the law, and will provide suitable resources as may be required to meet this commitment. Health & Safety Management will involve effective planning and organisation to develop and implement systems that will enable the control, maintenance & improvement of safety performance.

Eton Manor RFC as far as reasonably practical will:

- Provide and maintain equipment systems of work that are safe and without risks to health, that is a safe place of work, and a safe system of work.
- Ensure the safety and absence of risk to health in connection with the use, handling, storage or transportation of articles and substances.
- Provide such information, instruction and training and supervision as may be necessary to ensure the health and safety of its employees.
- Take appropriate preventative and protective measures.
- Provide employees with health & safety surveillance where necessary.
- Appoint competent personnel to secure compliance with statutory duties.

This policy will be regularly monitored to ensure that it is being implemented. It will be reviewed regularly or as may be required by changing circumstances, and revised as necessary.
