CUSTOMER INFO

TICKETS

- Please ensure tickets are downloaded prior to arrival at the gate.

TRAVEL

- Do allow ample time for your journey.
- Do plan your travel in advance for the event. Planned roadworks can cause delays. You can check for any roadworks at www.roadworks.org
- Do tune into local radio and check social media for the latest travel updates.

WEATHER

- Do check the weather and bring weather proof clothing if appropriate.

ID

- Do bring valid photographic ID (Passport, UK Driving Licence), we operate a strict 'Challenge 25, Serve 18 Policy'. Please remember that legally there is no automatic right to be served alcohol. Service is always at the discretion of the licensee.

RESPECT

- Do be patient.
- Do arrive at the venue in good time prior to the start of the concert, there will be security checks in place.
- Do leave the event quietly and please respect our neighbours.
- Do put any rubbish in the bins provided for you.



SAFETY & SECURITY

BAGS & VALUABLES

- Do not bring a bag if you can possibly avoid it. If you must please don't bring one larger than an A4 sheet of paper.
- Do not bring any valuables if it can be helped.

BANNED & PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Do not bring food and drink into the venue - a doctor's note will permit food/drink required for medical conditions. Cups of water are available at the bars free of charge.
- Do not bring glass containers - including perfume and aftershave.
- Do not bring camping chairs, folding chairs, gazebos or picnic blankets.
- Do not bring professional cameras, video cameras or audio recording devices.
- Dogs are not permitted, except assistance dogs.

RE-ENTRY

- We operate a strict no re-entry policy

AGE RESTRICTIONS

- Children under 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Babes in arms are free.
- For child safety please ensure ear defenders are worn.
- All ticket holders may be asked to produce proof of age upon entry and at the bars.

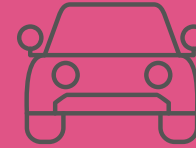
SEARCHES

- Searches will be in operation at this event – bags will be searched. No bags over the size of A4 will be allowed into the arena.

BEHAVIOUR

It is our intention for you to enjoy the event. Please help us by being kind and courteous to our team and other concert goers. Aggressive and abusive behaviour will not be tolerated. If you display such behaviour you will be asked to leave the venue immediately.

GETTING HERE



IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT THAT YOU PLAN HOW YOU GET TO THE CONCERT IN ADVANCE. THERE ARE A NUMBER OF ROAD CLOSURES AND PARKING SUSPENSIONS IN PLACE FOR THE DURATION OF THE EVENT DAY.

PARKING

Limited parking is available at the venue and must be booked in advance. This can only be accessed from the town end of Neasham Road as the A66 will be closed.

Please note that cars will not be able to leave the car park until approx. 15 minutes after the show has ended to allow safe exit of pedestrians.

Council Car Parks in the centre of Darlington will be free from midday on a first come first served basis.

Parking restrictions will be in place around the arena. A local residents parking scheme is in place on event days preventing parking on local and nearby streets.

Enforcement Officers will be on patrol on the day and cars parked in breach of parking regulations may be fined or removed.

BLUE BADGE PARKING

There are a number of blue badge spaces at the venue and must be booked in advance.

SHUTTLE BUS

The Shuttle Buses will run from the Dolphin Centre (DL1 5RP) from midday on Saturday 5th August 2023 with buses leaving at regular intervals.

Return bus service will run from the pick-up point at The Darlington Arena from 10pm with a regular service back to the Dolphin Centre.

We strongly advise that you book the Shuttle Service

TAXIS & DROP OFFS

A taxi drop off point will be in operation at the stadium. No parking or drop off's on or near to the A66. The A66 is a national highway and as such law enforcement will be patrolling and will issue on the spot fines anyone ignoring this request.

EXITING

To allow everyone to exit smoothly, please follow any directional signage, and instructions from stewards. Please take your time, and be kind and thoughtful to other concert goers and residents when leaving the venue. Please bear in mind the exiting times when advising taxis and pickups.

EVENT AREA

ENTRANCES

- There are three entrances into the main event arena, one for Seated, one for Gold and Accessible and one for General Admission. Each entrance will be clearly signed. Please use the entrance that corresponds to your ticket.

SEATING

- This event is a standing event.
- You are NOT permitted to bring camping furniture of any kind into the event.

ACCESSIBILITY

- The event takes place on grass with flat hard paths.
- Friendly stewards will be around to assist and accessible toilets will be available.
- The event area is suitable for wheelchair users with assistance.

The accessible areas are sold out, if extra space does become available this will be on a first come first served basis.

WEATHER

- The concert will not be cancelled in the event of inclement weather.
- Please be mindful of the weather and wear appropriate clothing and footwear.
- Umbrellas are permitted in the standing areas but must be taken down during the show.

TOILETS

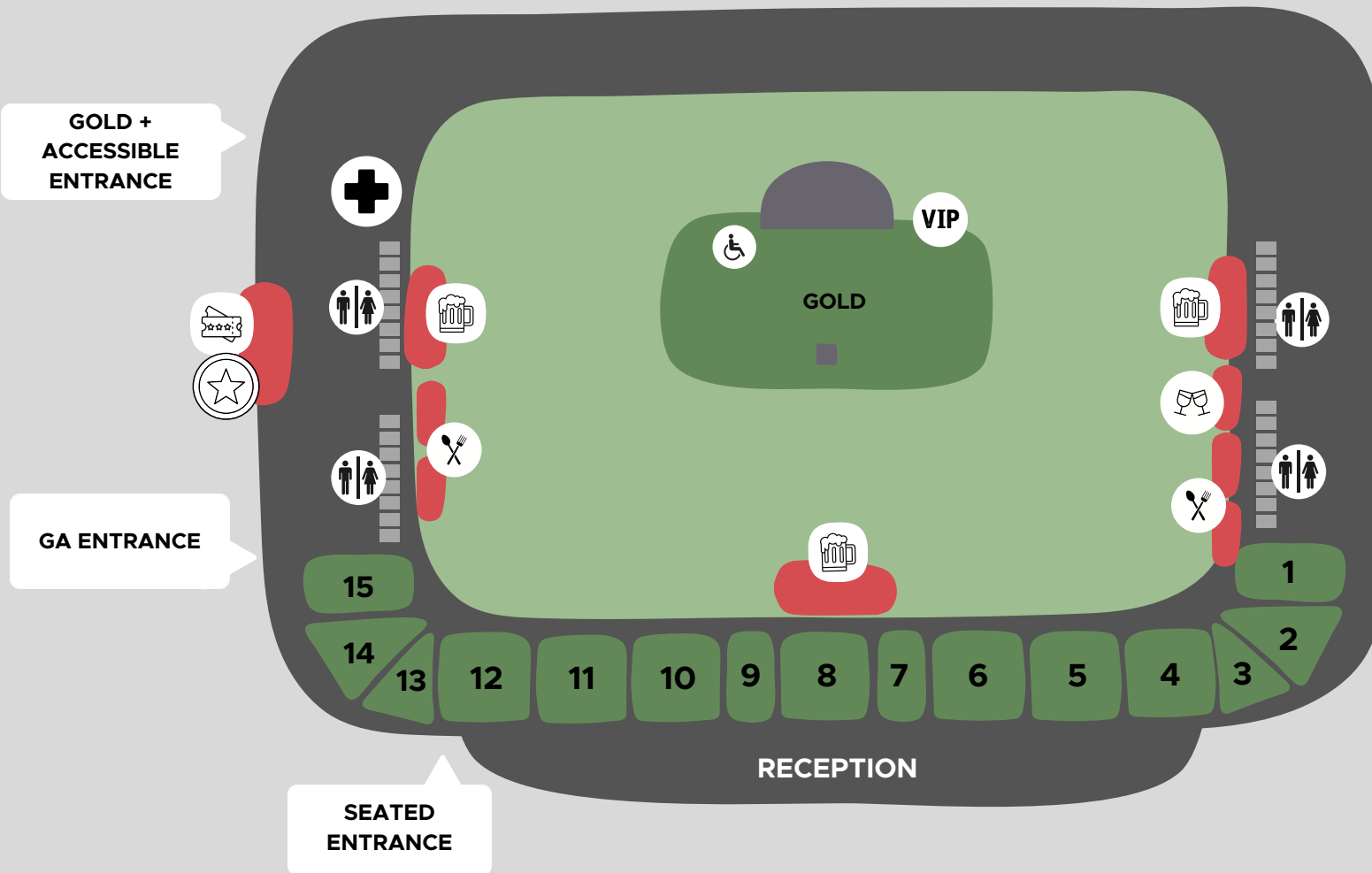
- Standard and accessible toilets facilities are located throughout the event area.

- Please note that tokens are for drinks for the bars only and not the food outlets.

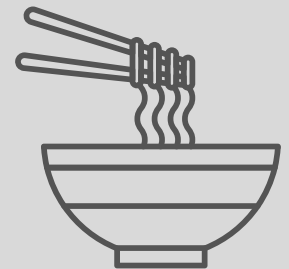
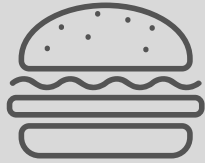
REFRESHMENTS
