Following a good 2nd half performance and win against Pucklechurch Res we go into today's game with a changed side. We started the game with well and within 5 minutes Steve Hall was played in on the right but his shot was well saved by the Lawrence Rovers keeper. With both sides looking to get the ball down and play football it was an entertaining game to watch. After a heavy tackle Liam made way for AJ who moved up front with Ryan going out to the left. With 25 minutes gone Lawrence Rovers started to make use of the wind and had a couple of good opportunities on the break but on each occasion failed to hit the target. The game was very even and following a good passage of play involving AJ and Jack, which found Ryan on the edge of the box with his shot finding the bottom corner. 0 - 1. The goal kicked Lawrence rovers into action and they started to put us under more pressure and had 3 corners in quick succession. As the ball was cleared it was played out wide and cross was headed in giving Jason in goal no chance. 1 - 1.

We started better in the 2nd half and used the wind well with Ryan getting the best of his marker a couple of times but he was unable to find a final ball. After 20 minutes we had the best chance of the 2nd half as the ball was played into the box Steve Hall found himself unmarked on the penalty spot but his shot was straight at the keeper. With 20 minutes left Lawrence Rovers started to push players forward to try and find the winner. Bondy replace Kev Bence at right back and he was called into action as he headed away from inside the 6 yards box. As time went on Lawrence Rovers pushed more players forward and on two occasions Jason made outstanding saves. The first was from a freekick that was going in the top corner. The 2nd was following a deflected shot with Barry heading away the rebound. Our goal was coming under more pressure and Jason was called into action again as this time he punched away a dangerous cross. For all the pressure we were under we did look dangerous on the break, but could not create and clear opportunities.




Wick FC Club Rules

In order for the club to successfully run three sides, it is appropriate that we remind everyone of the clubs expectations. The club now has the strongest squad for many years and team selection is an increasing hard task. The aim of the club is to have the first team promoted to the Gloucestershire County League and both the reserves and A team promoted within the District League to be near as is possible to the first team. To achieve this we need team managers who are winners and a squad of players with a desire to win. We believe we are lucky to have both.

The club expects the managers to be as fair as is possible as much as success on the field will allow and equally the club has expectations of its players. With the number of players now available for selection, it seems timely that we remind everyone of what those expectations are. Failure to comply with these expectations may or will result in non-selection for any Wick side.

Wick will expect that:

- All players must make themselves available for selection to any of the three club teams.
- All players should attend training on Tuesday unless there is a good reason and not without an apology.
- A player should not be asked to start as substitute for more than two weeks in succession unless there are exceptional circumstances.
- After two successive weeks starting as substitute, a player will be offered a full game in the team beneath that for which he has been sub or a starting place in the A team, if it was for the A team that he has been a sub, if circumstances allow.
- Any player refusing to start as a substitute for any of the club teams should consider themselves unavailable for selection to any of the three club sides.
- Players who owe outstanding fines or subs will be considered unavailable for selection.

Failure to accept these general rules would make team selection impossible, therefore all team managers will be asked to enforce these rules, unless there are exceptional circumstances and with agreement of the chairman. The managers will endeavor to be fair, however should anyone have a grievance, they can choose to discuss the problem with the team manager concerned or direct it to the committee via the players representative Jason 'Chico' Johnson.

The club understands that a player would not normally choose to be a substitute, but they should expect that they will start as substitute on occasion. It must also be recognised that when all registered players are available for selection, we will have more players than the three teams can accommodate. As a result there will be players who will not be picked for any of the three sides. To these people we apologise and ask that they through attending training press their case for future selection.

A TEAM END OF SEASON REPORT



Euro 2008

The 2008 UEFA European Football Championship, commonly referred to as Euro 2008, will take place in Austria and Switzerland, from 7 June to 29 June 2008. It is the second successful joint bid in the competition's history, following the UEFA Euro 2000 hosted by Belgium and the Netherlands. The 2012 competition in Poland and Ukraine is scheduled to become the third jointly-hosted tournament.

A total of 16 teams will participate in the tournament. Austria and Switzerland will automatically qualify as hosts; The remaining 14 teams have been determined through qualifying matches which started in August 2006. Austria and Poland will be making their first appearance in the tournament. The winner of Euro 2008 will represent the UEFA at the 2009 FIFA Confederations Cup.

The group stages of the finals will see the 16 finalists drawn into 4 groups. The teams will play 3 matches in a league format with the top 2 teams qualifying for the quarterfinals. The final is on 29th June 2008 in Vienna and Switzerland will open the tournament on Saturday 7th June 2008 in Basle.


The opening game is on 7th June 2008 at the Basle Stadium between Switzerland and Czech Rep. Winners in 2004 were Greece, they are drawn in Group D. The most goals scored in a competition is 9, scored by Michel Platini – France.
