## Environmental Policy

Haywards Heath Rugby Football Club (HHRFC) recognises that its activities may have a direct or indirect effect on the local, regional and global environment.

We are committed to reducing harmful effects on the environment and promoting the understanding of sustainability in its broadest context.

### Waste reduction

It is most effective to minimise waste at source thinking about disposal of a product before making a purchase. HHRFC makes every effort to recycle its glass, cardboard, plastics, food and packaging of any kind.

### Energy and water saving

Energy production consumes valuable non-renewable resources and causes massive pollution.

Action points for energy efficiency include switching lights off wherever possible; using reminder labels next to light switches; using energy efficient light bulbs; using electrical equipment efficiently and ensuring radiators have adjustable controls.

Action points for water efficiency include installing water saving devices in toilet cisterns; regularly checking for leaky taps, pipes and toilets and repairing them immediately.

HHRFC has been mindful of these points and more in the planned new HHRFC Clubhouse Project with sustainable solutions being implemented throughout the new build plans, with particular emphasis on energy and water efficiency.

### Travel

HHRFC aims to reduce the impact of vehicle emissions by encouraging sustainable principles when travelling. In addition to pedestrian travel to home games, we encourage lift sharing at all times and also provide coach or minibs transport to away games whenever possible.

EV charging points are going to be installed in the new Clubhouse carpark and will be available to encourage a medium term switch to electric vehicles by all.
