CLUBHOUSE LOTTO FAQ

What is the Clubhouse Lotto?

The Lotto was established to raise money for the New Clubhouse Fund and for the Club's support and maintenance in the future, whilst enabling members to participate in regular draws with the chance of winning attractive prizes.

How can I participate?

To enter the Lotto you must commit to paying £10 per month, either by standing order or by electronic bank transfer. Of course, you may purchase more than one entry, as a number of existing members have done.

What do I get for my money?

As soon as your first monthly payment is received, you become eligible to participate in each subsequent prize draw. Half of the money received goes towards the Clubhouse Development Fund and the other half is returned in prizes.

How are the Lotto prizes calculated?

There are regular prizes of £120 – winning one of these pays for your annual subscription! Six such prizes will have been drawn by the end of 2019; at least one will be drawn each month from then on.

Twice a year, there will be a major prize draw. The amounts of these prizes will depend on the total amount contributed. The total prize fund for any twelve month period (from April to March) will be one-half of subscriptions received during that period.

When are the prizes drawn?

The monthly prizes are normally drawn on the last Sunday in each month, after Mini training. The next major prizes will be drawn prior to the start of the 2020/21 season. The amount then in the prize fund cannot be known until nearer the time but, on current numbers, prizes of £500 and £1,000 may be anticipated.

How are the prizes drawn?

An alpha list of Lotto members is maintained and each entry allocated a number. Numbers are drawn either by a random number generator or by pulling tokens from a hat and the winning numbers cross-referenced with the membership list.

How will I know if I have won a prize?

Winners will be announced at the draw on the day. If you have won, you will be informed by email. A list of winners is posted on the Club website.

What happens about prizes during periods where no rugby is played?

Prizes continue to accrue during the off season. Winners will be drawn and notified as soon as possible after rugby resumes. The same applies if for any other reason rugby is not played for a protracted period (as during the current COVID-19 pandemic).
