What will I study?

Academists will learn and gain an understanding of the sports and leisure sector, with a specific focus on the football industry. Qualifications and skills gained will enhance employability prospects, or improve opportunities to transition into further or Higher Education. The sports related qualifications will permit academists to learn about anatomy, physiology, nutrition personal fitness and wellbeing, and leading sports related activities.

If I join the course, what can it lead to?

By taking part in and successfully completing the course, you can progress (where applicable) to the next academic level; or into employment within the sports sector; jobs include: Personal Trainer, Strength & Conditioning Coach, Sports Nutritionist, Gym Instructor, Leisure Co-ordinator and many, many more! You may also gain credits which can be used when applying for University; or if your skills, talent and character are what we are looking for... a place in the first team at Corby Town FC!

What will it cost me?

The course is fully funded by the Government and therefore is free. The only additional cost is £150 which for your personal training kit, supplied by and is ordered centrally by the club, to ensure you receive the best possible price.

Who can apply for this opportunity?

To be eligible to join the Corby Town FC Academy, you must have completed your secondary education, not be attached to a college or other training provider and be under 19 years of age on commencement of the course.
