KEY DELIVERABLES

<u>Team Preperation</u>

- Plan, prepare and deliver individual coaching sessions for the Clubs senior squads.
- Ensure that all sessions are designed to develop the skills and understanding of the players in your squads.
- Evaluate coaching sessions and games with the coaching team and players.
- Ensure specialist equipment such as weights, scrum machines, tackle bags, etc are used only if there are qualified supervisors present.
- Take responsibility for the upkeep and security of all coaching and training equipment.
- Mentor and advise assistant coaches and players where appropriate.

Games

- Form part of the team selection committee alongside club captain and other coaching staff, overseen by the Vice President - Playing where required.
- Attend all matches involved with the Club's first XV.
- Provide feedback to coaches, players and the Committee on performance.

Culture

- Lead by example and build a culture of respect, inclusivity and togetherness amongst the squad
- Take responsibility for the recruitment and retention of players.
- Work with the Club Committee to identify any areas of rugby equipment spend and to help plan any club events/activities.
- Be aware of all administrative procedures regarding player registration and eligibility.
- Advise Club Committee well in advance if any of the above responsibilities cannot be met at any time.
