Ryan Burgess rejoined his first club in January last season after a spell with Heriot's FP. The former young player of the season has had a huge impact since returning, scoring 9 tries in the East 3 Championship run-in, including a hat-trick at home to Walkerburn, as well as the title-deciding score at St Boswells on the last day of the season in what was also a man-of-the-match-winning display.

Having moved from the back three to scrum-half to cover injury this season, Ryan has helped himself to 3 tries and 2 more MoM performances, scoring at Penicuik before a brace at Edinburgh Northern two weeks ago. Possessing great feet and electric pace, Burgess is a game-breaker who punches well above his weight, and is a key player in our backline wherever he plays.
