- Ensuring that all activities undertaken are appropriate to the age, maturity, experience, and ability of their players.
- Encouraging the children/young people in their team to accept responsibility for their own behavior and performance.
- Clarifying with children/young people and their parents/carers what is expected of them on and off the rugby field.
- Working in partnership with other professionals match officials, doctors, physiotherapists, teachers etc. to ensure the well-being, safety, and enjoyment of all children/young people.
