Introducing: Green Laces



Thank you for supporting Quilter Kids First. As you know this is a fantastic way to upskill coaches and create a great rugby environment, so that everyone stays in the game for longer.

The green laces help to recognise and reward, on a weekly basis, the players in U7-U13 Age Grades who are demonstrating rugby union's core values; teamwork, respect, enjoyment, discipline & sportsmanship.

Here's how you can use them:

1. **Identify** - work with all other coaches/teachers at your club/school select a maximum of 2 players aged 6-13 who demonstrate rugby unions core values. These can players from another team of course!
2. **Reward** - present the selected players with a pair of green laces and a player certificate, explaining how they have demonstrated rugby unions' core values. You'll find editable posters on the England Rugby Brand Centre.
3. **Broadcast** - publicise the players achievements using the 'clubhouse' poster and share on social media using #QuilterKidsFirst

This initiative should be a positive reward for the kids and will help you raise awareness of what your club or school is doing to inspire a lifelong bond with our sport.
