# WHAT CHILDREN LEARN FROM RUGBY UNION

### TEAMWORK, RESPECT, ENJOYMENT, DISCIPLINE AND SPORTSMANSHIP

## THROUGH:

- Child-first approach and the coaching of fundamentals
- Focus of the sport for all: everyone plays
- Ability to participate not on the ability to perform
- Promotion of the social aspect of sport and multi-positional play and activity
- Development of confidence and self esteem
- Celebration of success as the learning of new skills and understanding
- Enjoyment and engagement of the player in loworganisation games.

# HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- Enjoyment: respect all of the children's rights to equal coaching and playing time
- Respect the game and its traditions of fair play, equality and inclusion
- Support the referee
- Encourage all participants and applaud effort and good play from both sides
- Make sure the players thank the referee and opposition at the end of the game.

# PITCH SIZE

- 90m x 60m max
- Plus 3–5 metres for in goal



- 7 players per team (maximum)
- Games must have even numbers on each team



 The RFU strongly recommends the wearing of mouth guards. Ideally, these should be custom made from a dental impressior of the teeth

#### THE SCRUM



- All six players should be confident and competant to participate
- Players are indicated to come together by the call crouch-bind-set
- Uncontested scrums can be used if most appropriate

#### **SUBSTITUTIONS**



- Rolling subs are permitted
- It should only happen when there is a stoppage
- All players should get at least half a game



- A try is scored by placing the ball down over the opponents try line
- At this age the score is not important

#### **GAME LENGTH**



- · 2 x 25 minutes
- Up to 80 minutes per day
