COACH DEVELOPMENT

The Club will encourage and promote coach development with a view to as many coaches as possible obtaining ICC, UKCC Level 1 (Assistant Coach) and UKCC Level 2 (Coach) qualifications. A long term aim will be to have at least one UKCC3 Level Coach. Additionally volunteers with no qualifications will be encouraged to undergo an introductory helpers' course. Coaches and volunteers will also be encouraged to complete Child Protection and First Aid Courses.

DISCLOSURE

It is the aim of the Club to have all coaches and volunteers disclosure checked by Disclosure Scotland as soon as practicable. Pending these checks, the Club will obtain completed self declarations from all coaches and volunteers together with, in the case of coaches from overseas, completed application forms, third party references and such police checks as are available.
