- Balancing and body manipulation

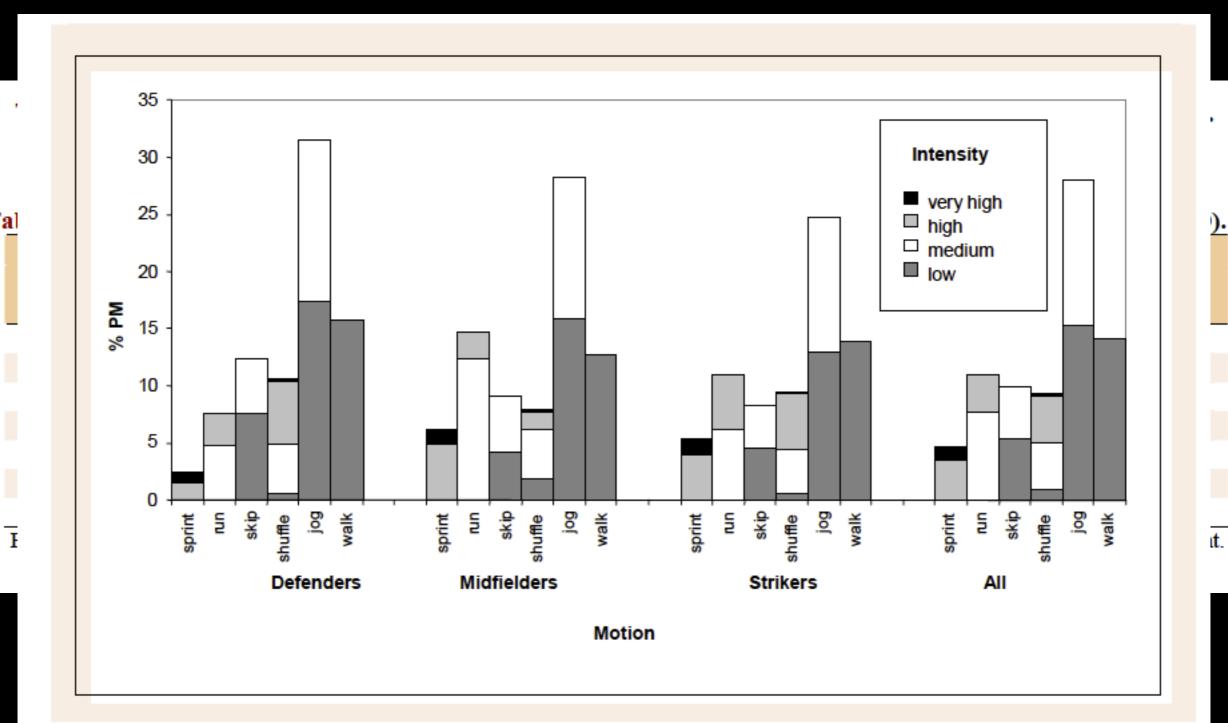


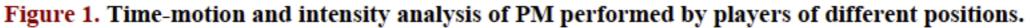

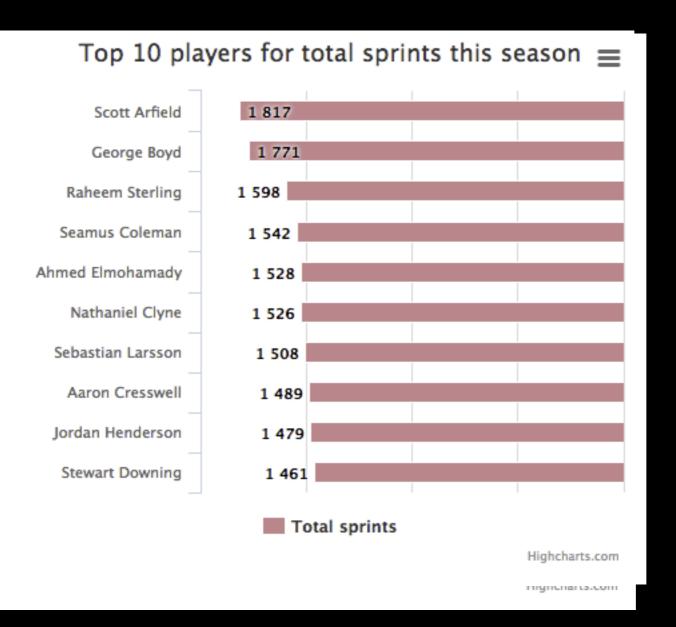

- What are the trade-offs?
- How will I ensure objectives are met without compromising learning?

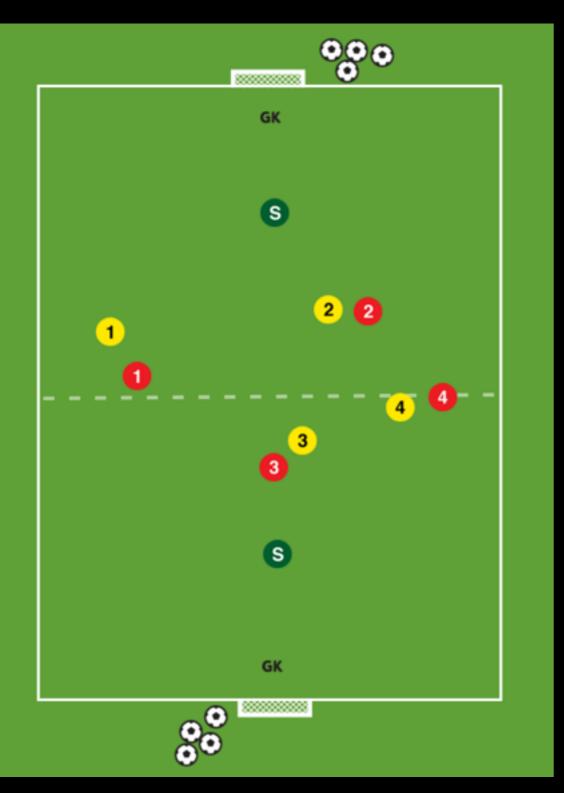


Methods...



- GAMES!
- Drive intensity of session and emphasise various physical outcomes through:
 - Conditions and Rules
 - Environment (pitch size, numbers, duration)
 - Competition

Practice 1.

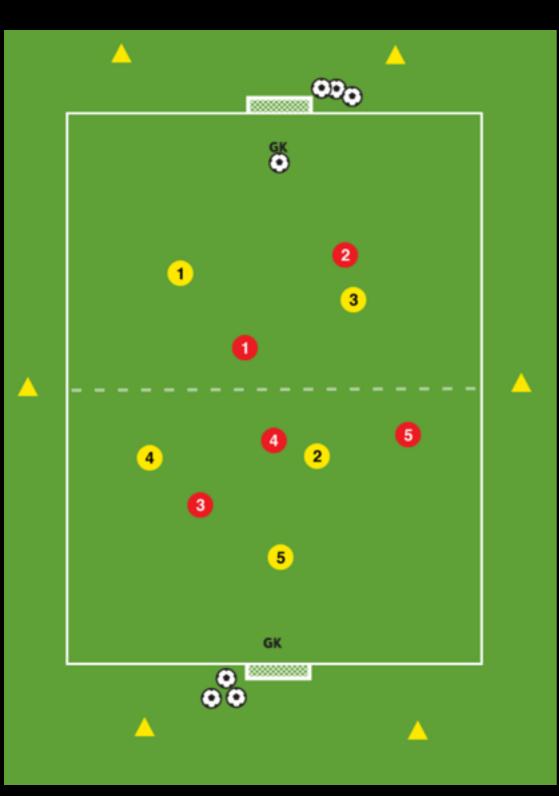




• 5v5 + GK's

- Each player partnered with opponent
- Players can only tackle opposing player
- 1 player from each team = sweeper
- Sweeper can tackle anyone but must play off 2 touches in possession
- 2 minute games, 1 minute recovery

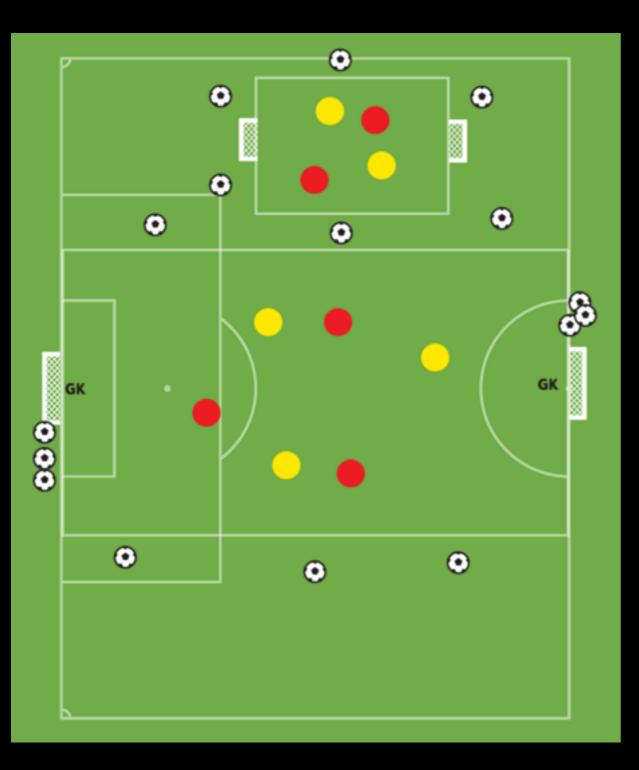
Practice 2..





- 5v5 + GK's
- Each player given a number
- Normal game rules apply
- Upon coaches call, that player must run around nearest marker before reentering play
- 4 minute games, 90 seconds recovery

Practice 3...





- 3v3 + GK's and 2v2
- Normal game rules apply
- 3 seconds to restart play
- 2 minute game, switch pitches, 2 minute game, 90 seconds rest

Group Tasks...

Role of the Coach...



- Motivate, manage intensity, drive effort, praise
- Referee/Enforce conditions or rules on practices
- Assess and monitor difficulty throughout
- Ensure realism and relevance is maintained
- Minimal coaching during session tech/tact info during rest periods

Age-Specific Alterations...



- Same practices!
- Consider altering:
 - Duration of work time
 - Length of rest time
 - Size of pitches
 - No. of players
 - No. of rounds

Expectations...



- Realistic as to what can be achieved with limited access
- Use of homework tasks or arrival activities for players linking 4 corners?
- Trade-offs during sessions!
