## **Photograph consent form**



Occasionally, we may take photographs of the children at our club. We use these images as part of our club displays and sometimes in other printed publications. We will also use them on our club website.

If we use photographs of individual children, we will not use the name of that child in the accompanying text or photo

## Conditions of use

This form is valid indefinitely from the date you sign it.

You may withdraw or amend permission at any time; however this must be done in writing by the parent or guardian of the child.

We will not re-use any photographs or recordings a year after your child leaves the club. Historic photographs could remain on our club website.

We will not use the personal details or full names (which means first name and surname) of any child or adult in a photographic image or video, on our website, in our club handbook or in any of our other printed publications.

If we use photographs of individual children, we will not use the name of that child in the accompanying text or photo caption.

If we name a child in the text, we will not use an individual photograph of that child to accompany the article.

We may use group photographs or footage with very general labels, such as 'Rugby Tour' or 'Saracens events.'

We will only use images of children who are suitably dressed, to reduce the risk of such images being used inappropriately.

Websites and social media platforms can be viewed throughout the world and not just in the United Kingdom where UK law applies.

Where consent is not given, head coaches will advise members, parents/guardians as is appropriate and reasonable, that photographs and videos should not be taken of any child other than their own.

Where consent is not given head coaches will advise any visiting or hosting clubs that the CRFC age group can not photographed or videoed.
