- Communicate, articulate and reinforce a clear coaching philosophy that is consistent across 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and development XV Rugby squads and includes all assistant coaches.
- Plan, prepare and deliver individual coaching sessions for the clubs senior squads.
- Ensure that all sessions are designed to develop the skills and understanding of the players in the squad.
- Working with Old Bedians Rugby Club committee to manage the club's level 2 coaches to support the coaching of teams where necessary.
  - Evaluate all coaching sessions and games with the coaching team and players.

The appointment will be on an initial 1 year term from July 2021 – May 2022 with the option to extend this following an end of year review.
