Neil has helped me at the Club for a number of years and brings with him not just two young boys mad on a cricket but a wealth of experience both on and off the field.

#### Gift Aid (please read and take the necessary action - thank you!)

As you will see below, we have been able to reduce juniors' subscriptions for the 2020 season! This has been made possible in large part because of the Gift Aid relief we receive on juniors' subscriptions in accordance with HMRC rules (at the basic rate tax @25%). But we need all eligible parents who are UK tax payers to tick the Gift Aid consent box in your account on the website: www.brookcricketclub.com or to complete a simple (paper) Gift Aid declaration form. Doing this reduces your tax bill too!

We believe that, in some cases, the parent completing the online details on the website may not be an eligible tax payer and that this is why the Gift Aid box is not ticked. We fully understand this but would simply ask that, if the other parent/guardian is a UK tax payer, s/he completes the paper Gift Aid declaration attached and return it to our Treasurer, Andrew Herring, as indicated in the form.

## Coaching for 2020

The Club's primary focus again this year is to give girls and boys aged 6 to 13 top quality coaching and match practice. The sessions will be run by our two professional coaches both of whom have immense cricketing and coaching knowledge.

We are offering a 14-week outdoor course commencing on Friday 24th April at the Brook cricket ground.

## **Soft Ball**

**U7s** (school years 1\* and 2): 17:00 -18:00 (\*juniors in the U7s must be at least 6 years old)

U8s and U9s (school years 3 and 4): 18:00 - 19:00

# **Hard Ball**

**U10s, U11s, U12s, and U13s** (school years 5, 6, 7 and 8): 19:00 - 20:15 (or until the light allows in the first few weeks)

The sessions have been arranged to take account of the coaches' availability and the need to accommodate both hard ball and soft ball cricket and will concentrate on the three core skill sets: batting, bowling and fielding.

Each player's cricketing skills will be reviewed regularly during the programme with the objective of maximising his/her potential. We will also be holding an awards evening at the end of the season to mark the achievements of all the children.

As well as offering a high-quality coaching programme, we have entered an U12s, an U10s and an U9s team in the new Surrey Cricketing League Programme.

Fixtures will be posted on the Club's website once agreed with the other clubs. On the 'Home' page, click on 'Teams' and navigate to the appropriate age group.

As always, we will be looking for parents' help in running league and friendly matches. Match managers, umpires and scorers are always required. Please contact any of the team below if you can help.
