



## UPTON CRICKET CLUB MEMBERS, GUESTS AND SPECTATORS JULY 2020

These guidelines are for all members, guests and spectators visiting Upton CC and follow ECB guidelines published to enable the return of recreational cricket.

- Please do not visit Upton Cricket Club if you are suffering from any of the COVID-19 symptoms or if you are in a period of self-isolation
- Please follow all the latest Government guidelines on social distancing and gatherings when on the premises.
- Upton Cricket Club is co-operating with the NHS Test & Trace system and will require details of all members, guests and spectators who use any of our facilities. This information will be kept securely for 21 days before disposal.
- There will no food served on the premises. Non-playing members, guests and spectators can bring their own and dispose of any rubbish in the bins provided.
- As per the terms of our Club Premises license, only members are permitted to purchase drinks at the bar and only alcohol purchased at the Club bar must be consumed with no alcoholic drinks to be brought into the ground.
- Payment should for drinks purchased at the bar should be made by contactless payment where possible.
- Please leave empty glasses at tables and benches and the Bar Staff will collect them.
- There will be a strict one-way system in place throughout the Clubhouse. Entry is via the front doors of the Clubhouse and the exit is via the tearoom. Exceptions to this are the Gents toilets where you will exit via the changing rooms, and for those playing on the back pitch who use the toilet facilities in the Tearoom.
- Due to the requirements of a one -way system the Tearoom toilets will be closed except to players on the back pitch. If you or a guest require the Disabled toilet, please speak to the Bar Staff.
- All members, guests and spectators must sanitise their hands when entering the Clubhouse
- Please do not stand or loiter in the Clubhouse or Tearoom with your drinks.
- There will be a regular cleaning regime of touch points in place.
- All tables and benches have been specifically placed to ensure social distancing. Please do not move them, add any additional seating to a table or add any additional seating within the area directly outside the Clubhouse on either the patio or grass area or use the wall for additional seating.
- When you vacate a table/bench located directly outside the clubhouse or tearoom, please advise one of the bar staff so they can be suitably cleaned ready for the next usage.
- Spectators may bring their own seating and place around the ground, ensuring they remain socially distanced at all times
- Irrespective of wherever spectators are seated around the ground you must be restricted to discrete six person gathering limits and spread out, in line with wider UK Government guidance.
- Parents are kindly asked to be responsible for their own children and ensure they maintain social distancing at all times.
- Spectators should refrain from any contact with the match ball
- If a match is being played, please keep clear of any spaces reserved for players and officials.
- In the event of bad weather, spectators can move into the Clubhouse and Tearoom if they are able to maintain social distancing. If not, spectators should make their own arrangements to shelter.

As we all know these are “unprecedented times” and the above will seem to be at odds in some cases with our normal way of doing things at the club. So please be patient with us if we may not have got things absolutely spot on and any constructive feedback is always welcome.
