

Good afternoon and welcome to The Stute, home of Ilkeston Rugby Union Football Club. I'd like to extend a particularly warm welcome to the travelling players, coaches and supporters of Nuneaton Old Edwardians RFC.

For our last fixture of 2023 we travelled over to Market Rasen which is always a tough place to go.

After a slow start the Elks didn't take the lead till the 36th minute with a Joel Haigh penalty and an unconverted Aaron Garvey try (7-8). Two further tries before half time by Aaron and Joel Naylor, one converted by Joel Haigh gave us a 7-20 half time lead. The second half started as the first finished with a Charlie Clarke interception to set up an easy conversion for Joel H, (7-27).

On 48 mins Joel Haigh ghosted through a gap to score under the posts which he converted himself. In the last 20 mins the fact that we had not played for four weeks was starting to show as we allowed Rasen to score three tries to make the final score 26-34 to Ilkeston.

Colts Update



Mansfield 26 Ilkeston 28

The Green Army travelled up to Eakring Road for a showdown under lights with Mansfield, the conditions were perfect, the welcome from Mansfield was fantastic.

From the whistle Mansfield made their intentions clear with a sweeping move that covered two thirds of the pitch, Ilkeston missed tackles or went too high on the bigger opponents and it was only a desperate last ditch effort from Nathan that forced Mansfield into touch metres from the Ilkeston line.

The lineout was knocked on over the Elks line and pounced on by the Mansfield hooker, the referee awarded a try but thankfully, after advice from his touch judge, a scrum to Ilkeston was given. From the scrum Oli cleared with a booming kick up the touchline and into Mansfield territory, the threat was cleared but the Elks had been warned of the power and pace of Mansfield.

Ignoring that warning the Elks switched off in the lineout, Mansfield won good ball and in a brilliant move with backs making ground and their forwards supporting they scored under the posts, 7-0. Surely the Elks would now switch on and get their tackles in?, unfortunately not, minutes later we were back behind our posts, conversion missed, 12-0.

Ilkeston then had a bit of possession and showed that they were, in parts, equal to Mansfield. The scrummage was immense all night, the lineout was working well and Olis boot was getting us into the right positions, a bit of pressure forced Mansfield into conceding a penalty and Oli put us on the scoreboard, 12-3.

Mansfield took a quick restart as the Elks were still celebrating their points but luckily it went straight out, more warning signs of the alertness and quick thinking of the home side, especially the No.10 who will become a star for the Club I'm sure. Still Ilkeston were lethargic around the pitch, good positions were squandered by lack of reaction and failure to get pods in place, scrum half Jake got the ball away constantly under pressure but due to the pressure it wasn't quality ball for the backs to run with. The penalty count rose and Mansfield pinned the Elks back in their 22, tackles again were missed and Mansfield scored from close range with no defence in site, conversion kicked, 19-3.

So, here we were, in exactly the position as the first game at The Stute, 19-3 down to a bigger side, playing expansive rugby. In that instance it was Sam Evans with a bit of quick thinking and genius that got us back in the game, it couldn't happen again could it? This time with the help of great line out possession, swift hands through the Centres of Fin and Arthur, Sam showed an electric turn of pace and outran the defence to score a try which showed just how simple it is to score a try when all the components are in place, Olis conversion made it 19-10.

So now we were back in the game, Alex and Rory were on with the instructions to smash rucks and get the tackling done that had been missing from the start, gradually we were getting a foothold in Mansfield territory but again the home side produced a break out, won ruck ball and the 10 skipped a couple of despairing arms to score a converted try under the posts, 26-10.

The Elks play was improving as we seemed to realise that we were as good as the opponents and we were soon putting pressure on them, a penalty was awarded which Oli converted with the last kick of the first half, 26-13.

A couple of changes in personnel were made at half time, but the major change was made by the lads themselves, there was a determination to prove they were a better side than the one that had shown itself in that opening 20 minutes, suddenly tackles were being made, pods were formed, tip ons to put runners into space, and changes in angles and runs from the backs were made, it was almost as though we had been doing this in training for the last 3 months.

Our scrum continued to dominate, we were on top in the loose play and our tackling was immense, Mansfield were pressured into conceding penalty after penalty and quality ball was coming out to the backs, a lovely move along the line with Oli, Fin, Arthur and Sam instinctively knowing just when to release a pass resulted in Nathan scoring, how he managed to somehow hold on with one hand pinning the ball almost to his back I don't know!, the conversion by Oli just falling short, 26-18.

The Elks were now relishing the challenge, a barnstorming run from Rory got us back into their 22 but a harsh penalty, and a yellow card!, put us back in our own half, another great run from Alex got us back up there but the intervention of the touch judge brought another penalty and back we went. In the first half these incidents would have led to scores from Mansfield but the intensity of the Elks defence seemed to dent their confidence.

A Mansfield yellow card brought it back to 14 a side but with Rory's sinbin being over first the quick thinking Elks made full use of a temporary extra man and ran from their own 22, sublime handling again got it out to Man of the Match Nathan who beat the first man, put a little chip in, gathered it and scored, brilliant!! As was the conversion!, 26-25.

With minutes to go the Elks didn't panic, a long shot at goal was turned down as the lads were confident that a further chance would come, it did, as Mansfield tried to run out of defence they were caught offside from their own knock on and Oli claimed the winning points with the last kick of the game, 26-28.

An epic game of Rugby played in the right spirit with just a little edge to it between 2 very good sides.




Club Notices AKA Club Moans


