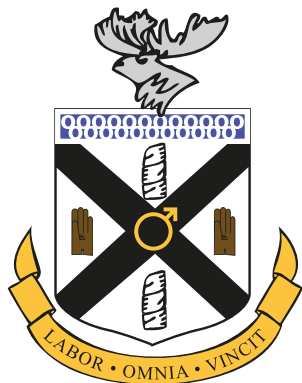

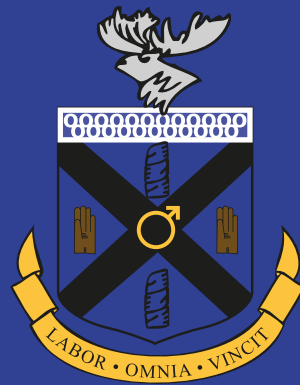

Ashbourne 22 Ilkeston 27



FINDING ANSWERS!!

A cracking game in the sunshine, both teams played some very good rugby in sticky conditions that, despite the sun, were very heavy and testing. The Elks had questions to answer after the poor display the previous week against Stamford, it's the sign of a good team that can bounce back and produce an effort like they did! A few changes were made from the previous week, some positional, some due to injuries and unavailability, but such is the depth of talent in the group it was still a very strong side.

Preparation on the day was a bit haphazard due to traffic, the geography of the changing rooms and pitch and the usual game of parking Tetris at Ashbourne. The first 10 minutes was spent as tackling practice for The Elks as Ashbourne battered our 5 metre line, they had big ball carriers and on another day we could have been our usual 14 points down without reply! Credit to the lads that they kept it to 7 in this period, first question answered.

Possession is always key in these conditions and if you can manage the referee he can become your extra man. To get that possession you have to hit rucks, take the opposition's space away and go forward, we did this, put them under pressure and caused a bit of dissent among their players, the penalties came, we marched up the pitch and scored a brilliant try in the corner with some superb handling, question 2 answered.

The lads were by now playing some very good rugby and just before half time scored another great try in the corner by piling the pressure on whilst in control, question 3 answered

In fairness we didn't want half time to come as we were dominating the game, we made changes in order to keep that pressure on and have fresh legs in our pack but our usual problems in restarting came back to haunt us, three missed tackles cost us a try and we were back under the cosh!

Some great play got us back in Ashbourne territory but a little bit of indiscipline cost us a penalty, a further 20 metres, a lineout lost and eventually a try. That put Ashbourne in front and the battle was on, another question, fight on or concede defeat? We fought on and produced a great try, repaying his debt to the team with the previous indiscipline Archie crashed over, question 4 answered.

The Elks were regaining control until a kick through and chase from Ashbourne produced one of the most generous penalty try decisions I've ever seen, a view shared by the opposition coach.

We were now behind but still playing well, a penalty got us back within one score, and we continued to press. The Ashbourne defence was proving as resilient as we were in the first 10 and with a combination of good clearance kicks and excellent chasing we found ourselves on our 22, 2 minutes to go, and 2 points behind. We could have panicked and thrown the ball about in desperation, chasing the game, instead we resorted to pattern, set up pods, and retained possession forcing Ashbourne into conceding a penalty in their 22, question 5 answered.

We kicked for the corner, won the lineout with some quick thinking, cleared 2 rucks, and Jonny crashed over for the try, converted by Sam and the win was in the bag, final question answered.

A great game of Rugby from both sides, numerous candidates for Man of the Match but won by Sam Evans for tackling like a 7 whilst running and distributing like a 10!

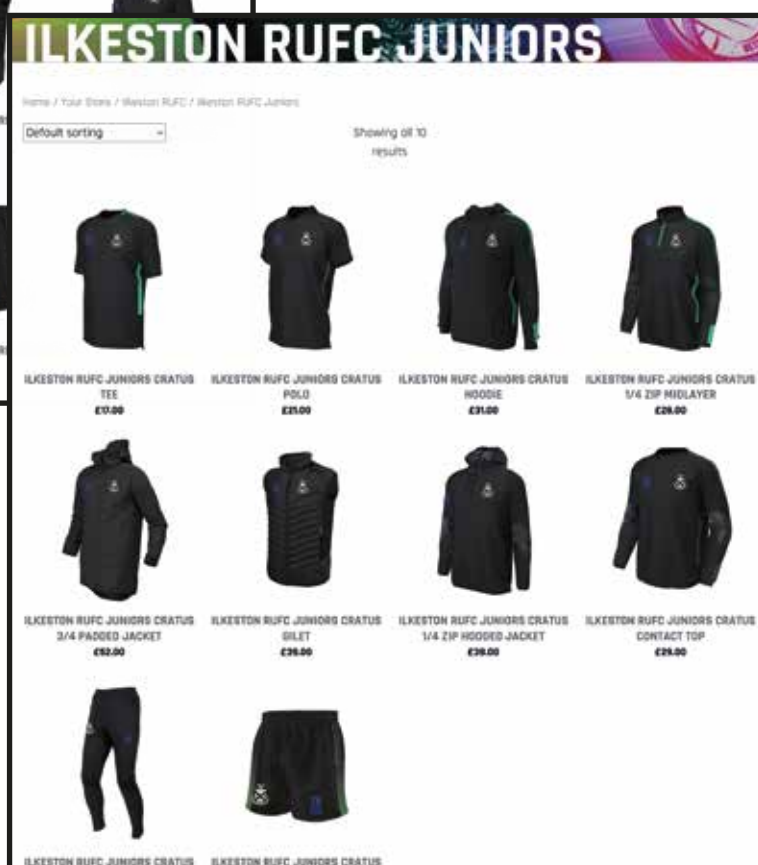
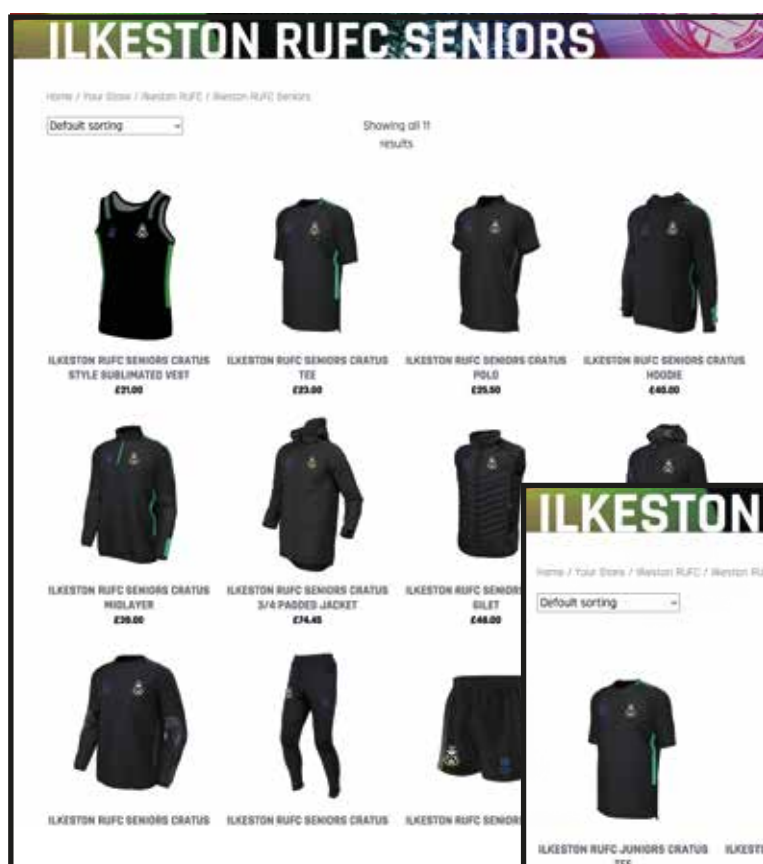

Club Notices

AKA Club Moans

Match Official Abuse NLD



There has been a lot of publicity recently about the RFU increasing punishments to crack down on an escalation in match official abuse that has been seen creeping into rugby over the past few years. I am pleased to say that Ilkeston RUFC has a good track record of taking the core values of our sport very seriously. It is something that can be seen in our coaches and subsequently in the behaviour of our players across all age groups of the club. However, this doesn't mean to say we should be complacent and the club committee would like to highlight what the recent directives from the RFU and NLD mean in practice. The NLD (Notts, Lincs & Derbys Rugby, the constituent body responsible for our rugby at a local level) have noted that even after introducing an aggravated tariff of 2 extra weeks to be applied to sanctions imposed by their disciplinary committee for instances of Match Official Abuse (MOA), they have noticed that the trend in MOA has increased again, both on pitch and more disappointingly, pitch side. There has been a marked increase in MOA by coaches, club officials and spectators/club members. The RFU report that MOA, particularly, is seen as instrumental to the increasing number of referees retiring from the game, in many cases solely as a result of the way in which they have been treated, abused and spoken to by players, spectators or club members.

The directive from the RFU now means that the NLD disciplinary panel will apply an additional 2 to 4 weeks extra to any sanctions they apply to players/clubs/coaches. In addition to this, action has also recently been taken against clubs where non-playing spectators and members have deemed to have been participating in MOA. One club had incidents at a colts game and now have a 10 point reduction to the club's 1st XV team (suspended and to be invoked applied if there is a repeat of this behaviour reported). Another club had a game abandoned and have had a 15 point reduction applied to their Senior 1st XV (this will be carried over and applied at the start of next season, because it was felt to apply it to the current season would have little to no effect due to their present position in the league).

Ilkeston RUFC would like to make it very clear to all players, coaches, supporters, parents, and anyone else attending our matches from the 1st XV to the U6s, any behaviour likely to be construed as Match Official Abuse will not be tolerated by the club. Everyone should understand that it has no place in our sport and any such behaviour could have serious consequences for the club as a whole.

Ilkeston RUFC welcome all match officials to our club, they are our guests and will be treated with the friendliness and the respect that they deserve. The club is grateful that these volunteers give up their free time for the good of the game we all love.
