

BRIGHTLINGSEA REGENT FOOTBALL CLUB INTERMEDIARY POLICY

Overview

The purpose of this policy is to outline how Brightlingsea Regent Football Club will deal with an intermediary or third party that claims to represent a player that is either currently contracted to Brightlingsea Regent Football Club, or a transfer target for the club.

General Terms

- 1. Brightlingsea Regent Football Club will only deal with FA Licensed Intermediaries and will ask to see the appropriate proof of accreditation as such;
- 2. No negotiation can take place between an Intermediary and Brightlingsea Regent Football Club unless initial permission is sought from the Secretary or the Chair;
- 3. No negotiation can take place between an Intermediary and Brightlingsea Regent Football Club unless the player in question has given explicit permission to do so;
- 4. Negotiations between Brightlingsea Regent Football Club and any Intermediary can only be undertaken by the respective First Team Manager or a Director of Brightlingsea Regent Football Club subject to the conditions in sections 1, 2 or 3 of this document;
- 5. A database of all FA Licensed Intermediaries who represent Brightlingsea Regent Football Club players will be kept by the Secretary;
- 6. No payment will be made by Brightlingsea Regent Football Club to any intermediary or third party for the purpose of player acquisition or contract negotiations.
- 7. Details of the relevant licensed intermediary must be entered into the relevant section of the FA contract;
- 8. No agent may attend any closed football session or trial match, irrespective of the team, unless prior permission has been sought from the Secretary and the relevant team manager;
- 9. No contact can be made by an intermediary to a player who is aged 17 years or less without strict permission of the parents or guardian of the player;
