

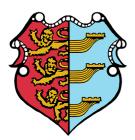
## **Dealing with an Incident/Accident**

## **Report Form**

Name of club:	Incident Guidelines
Site where the incident/accident took place:	(1) Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation. Is there danger of further injuries?
Address of injured person:	<ul><li>(2) Listen to what the injured person is saying.</li><li>(3) Alert the first-aider who</li></ul>
Post code:	should take the appropriate action for minor injuries.
Date and time of incident/accident:	<ul><li>(4) In the event of an injury regarding specialist treatment, call the emergency services.</li><li>(5) Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised.</li></ul>
