Whilst coaching and matches are supervised to minimise the risk of injury, rugby is a physical contact game. The RFU insurance scheme covers all paid up members of the Club, see <http://www.rfu.com/ManagingRugby/Insurance/PlayersParentsAndGuardians.aspx> but note that this is only basic cover and **DOES NOT** cover loss of earnings. The Club recommends that you consider taking out additional insurance.

Please note that the Club, its servants, agents or employees are not be responsible for supervising players before or after coaching sessions or matches. The RFU advises players to have an up to date tetanus injection. A properly fitted Gumshield is also recommended.
